Population and Growth

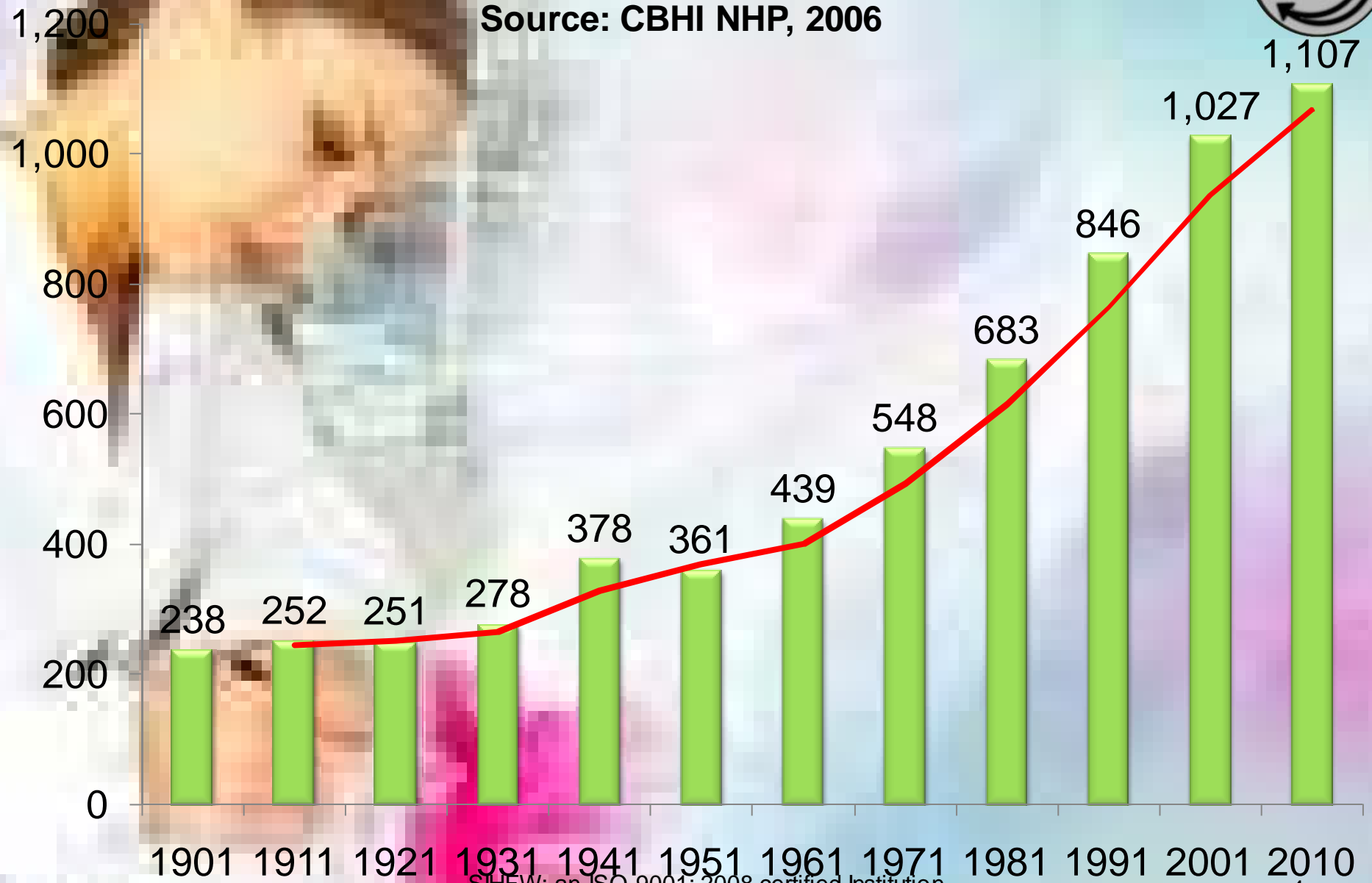


- Second most populous country in the world.

Population of India (In Millions)

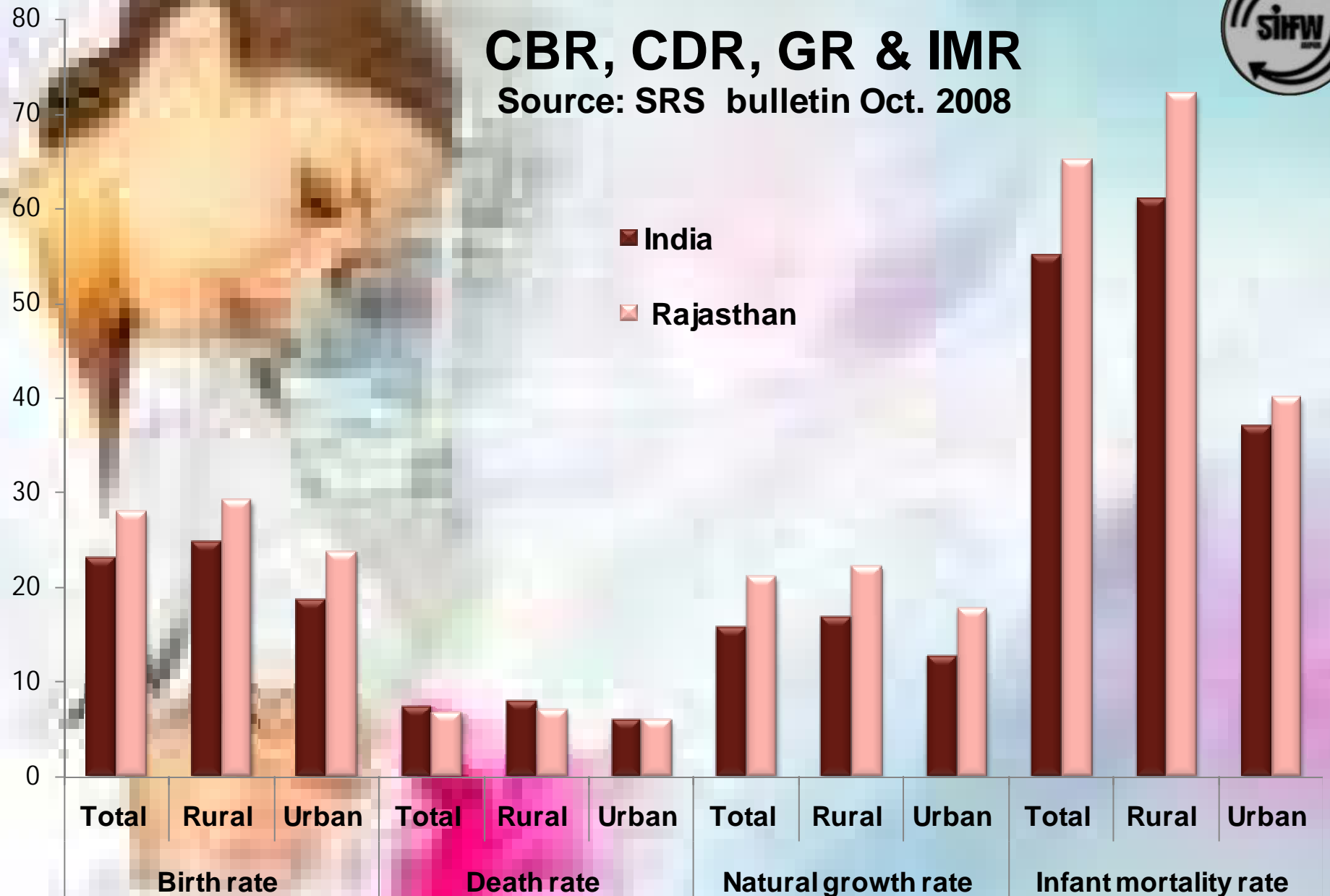

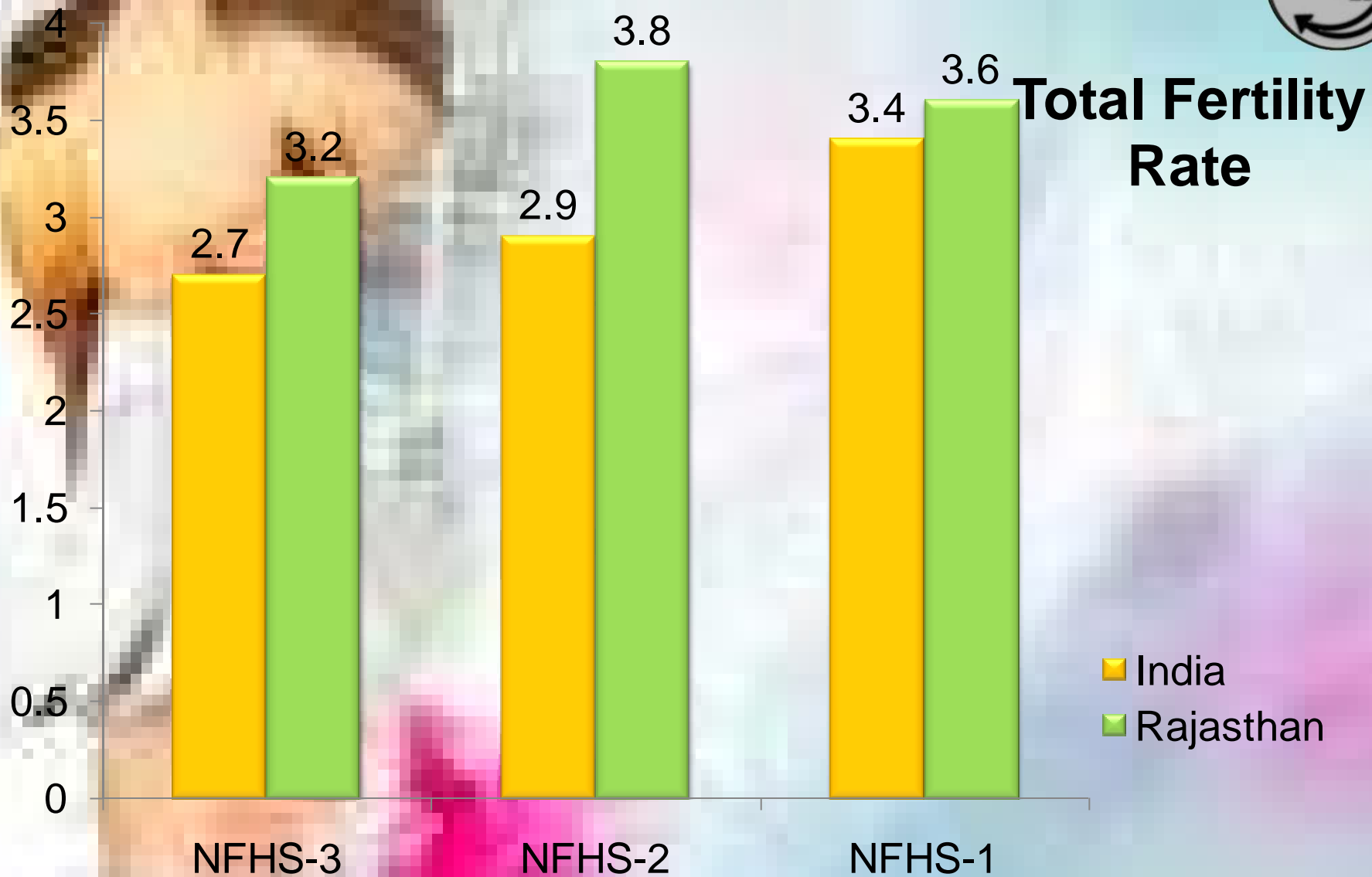

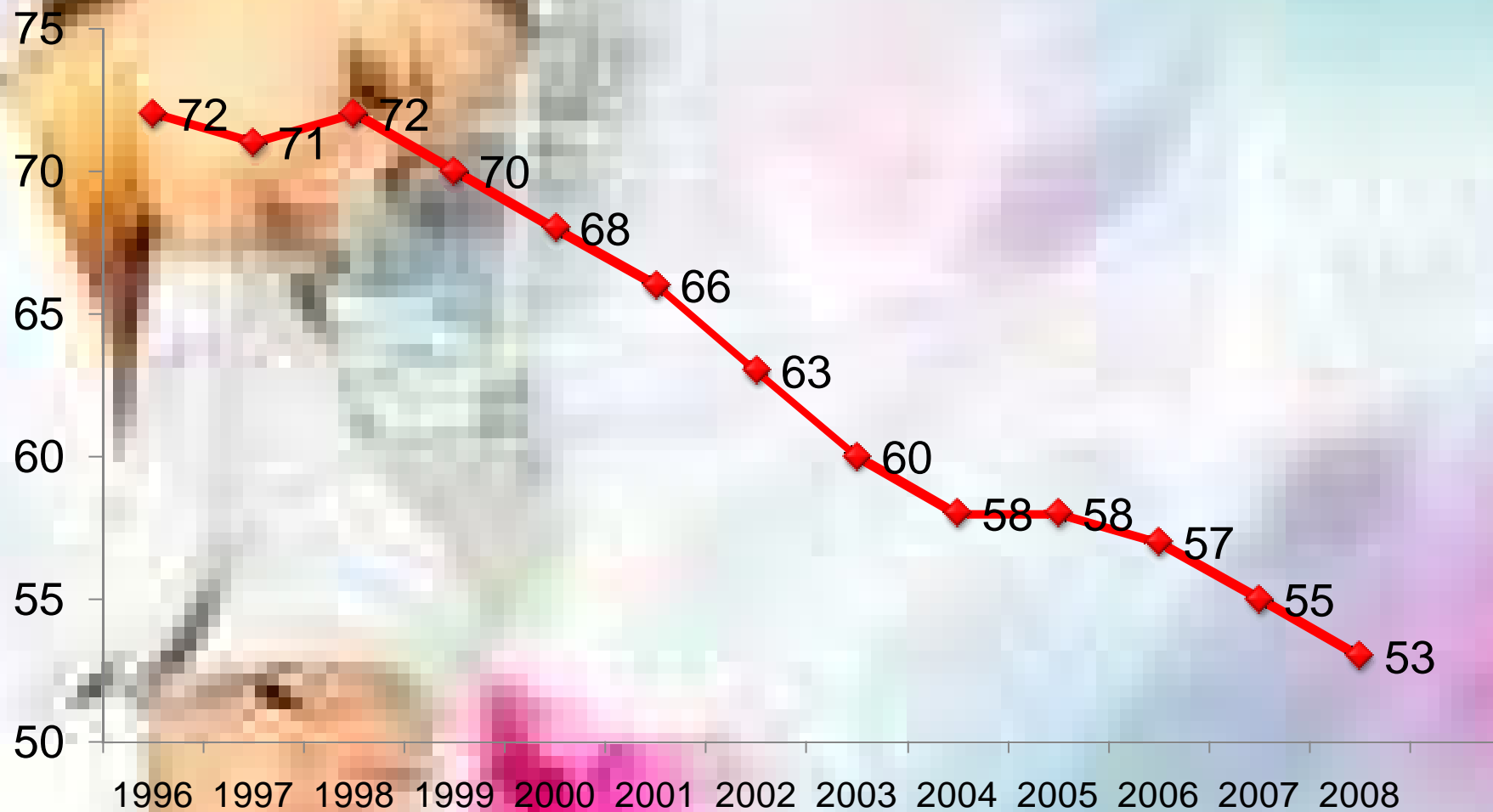






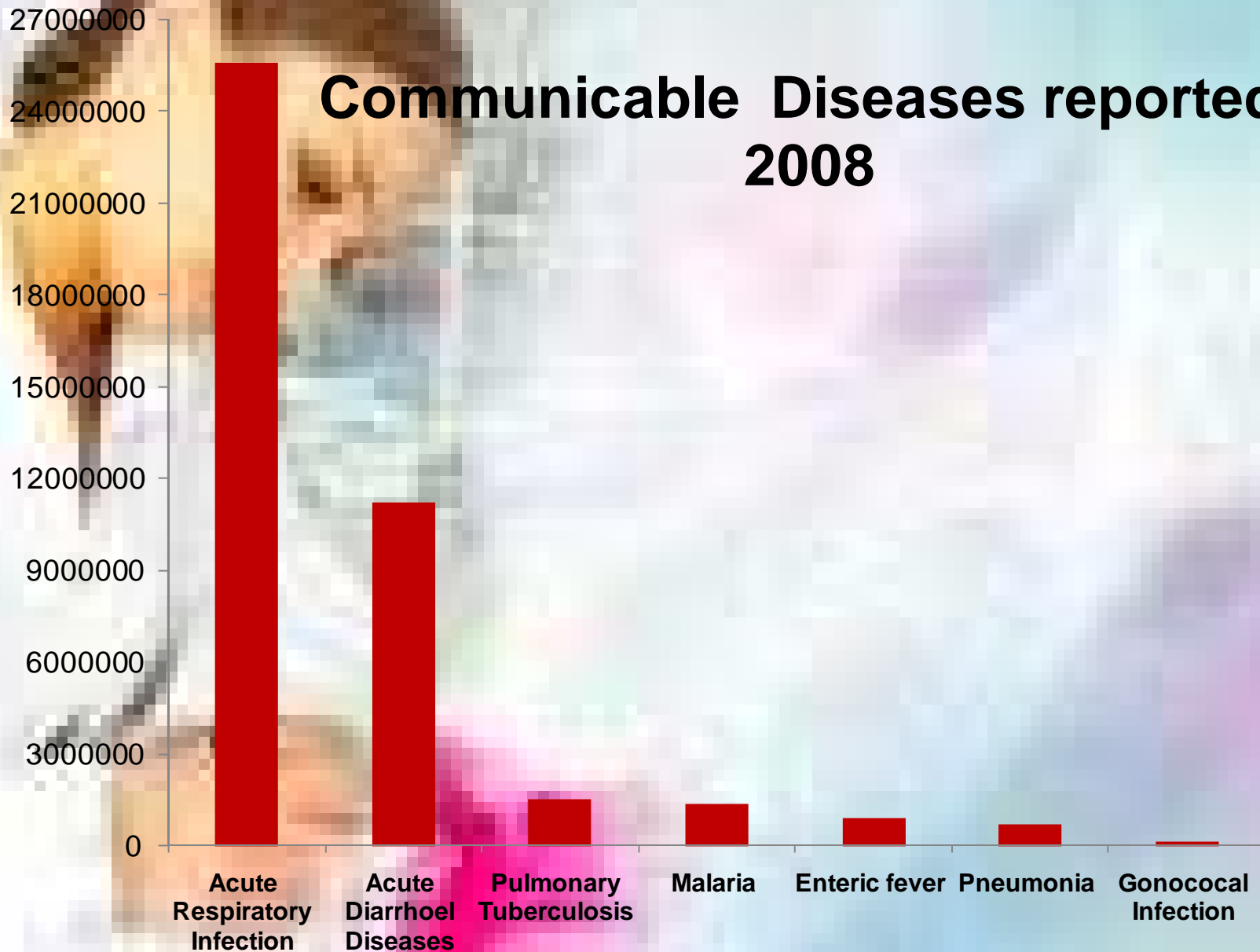
IMR India, 1994- 2008

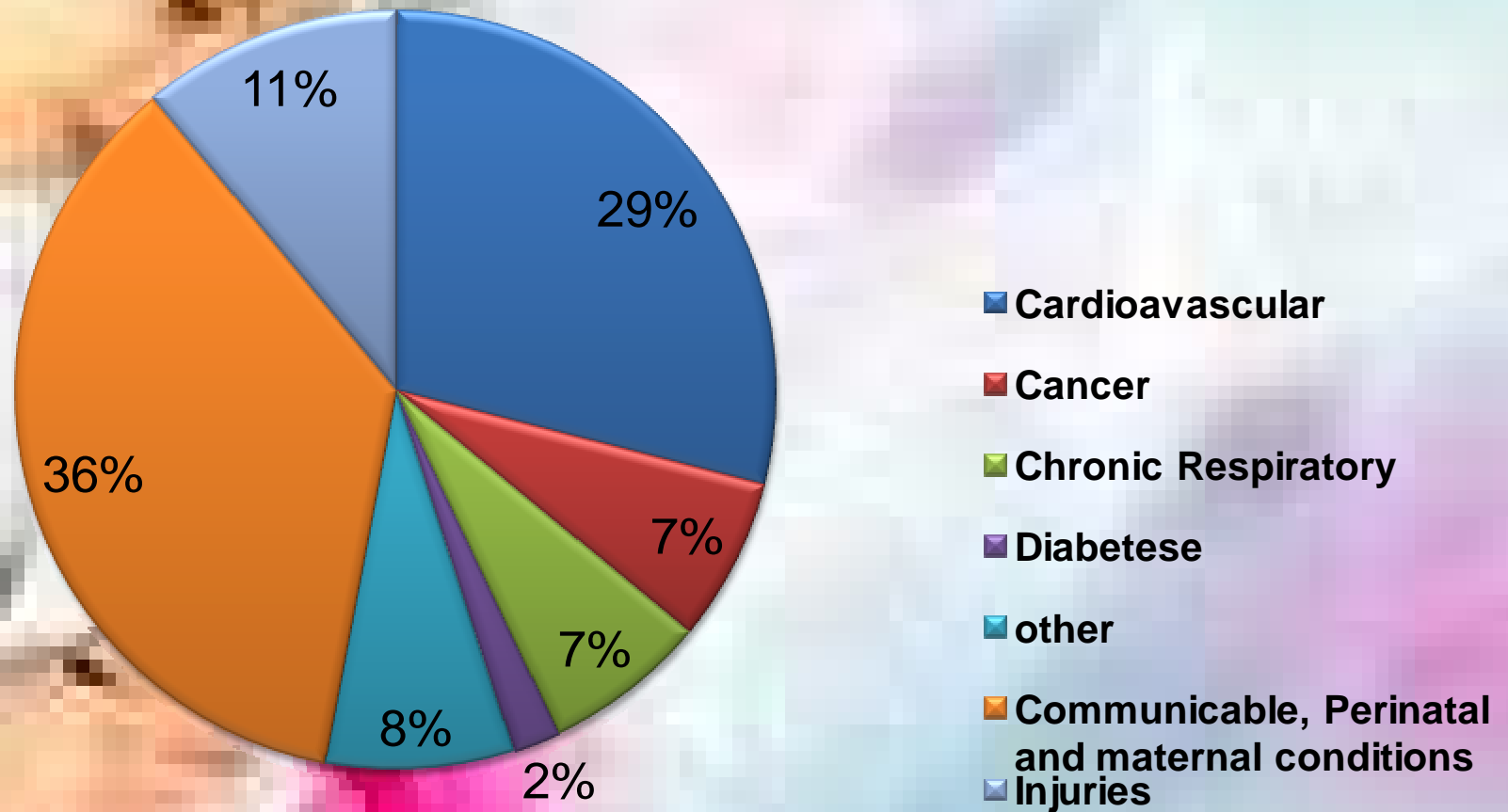


Communicable Diseases reported- 2008





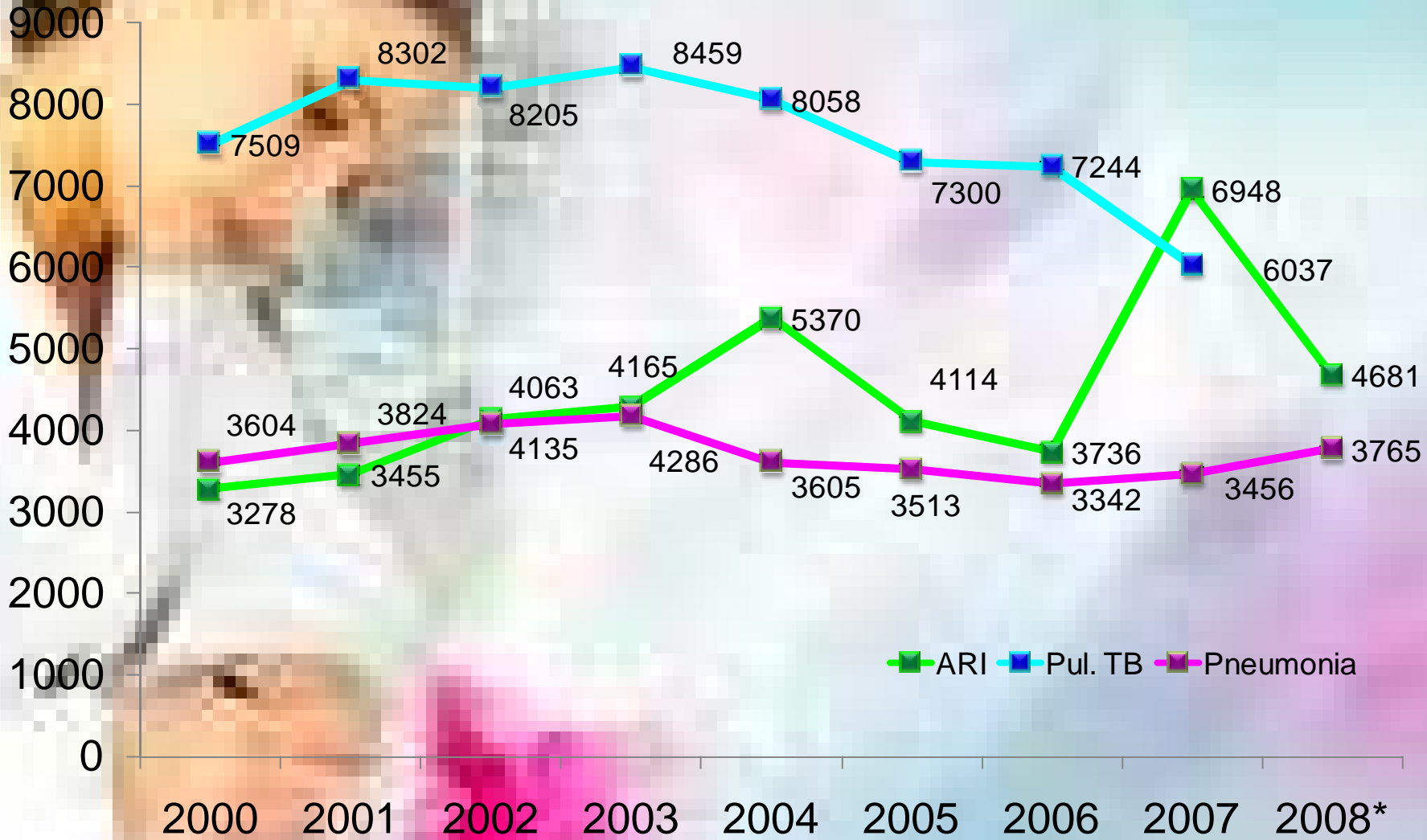
Major causes of Death: India 2005





Mortality Pattern- 2000-2008

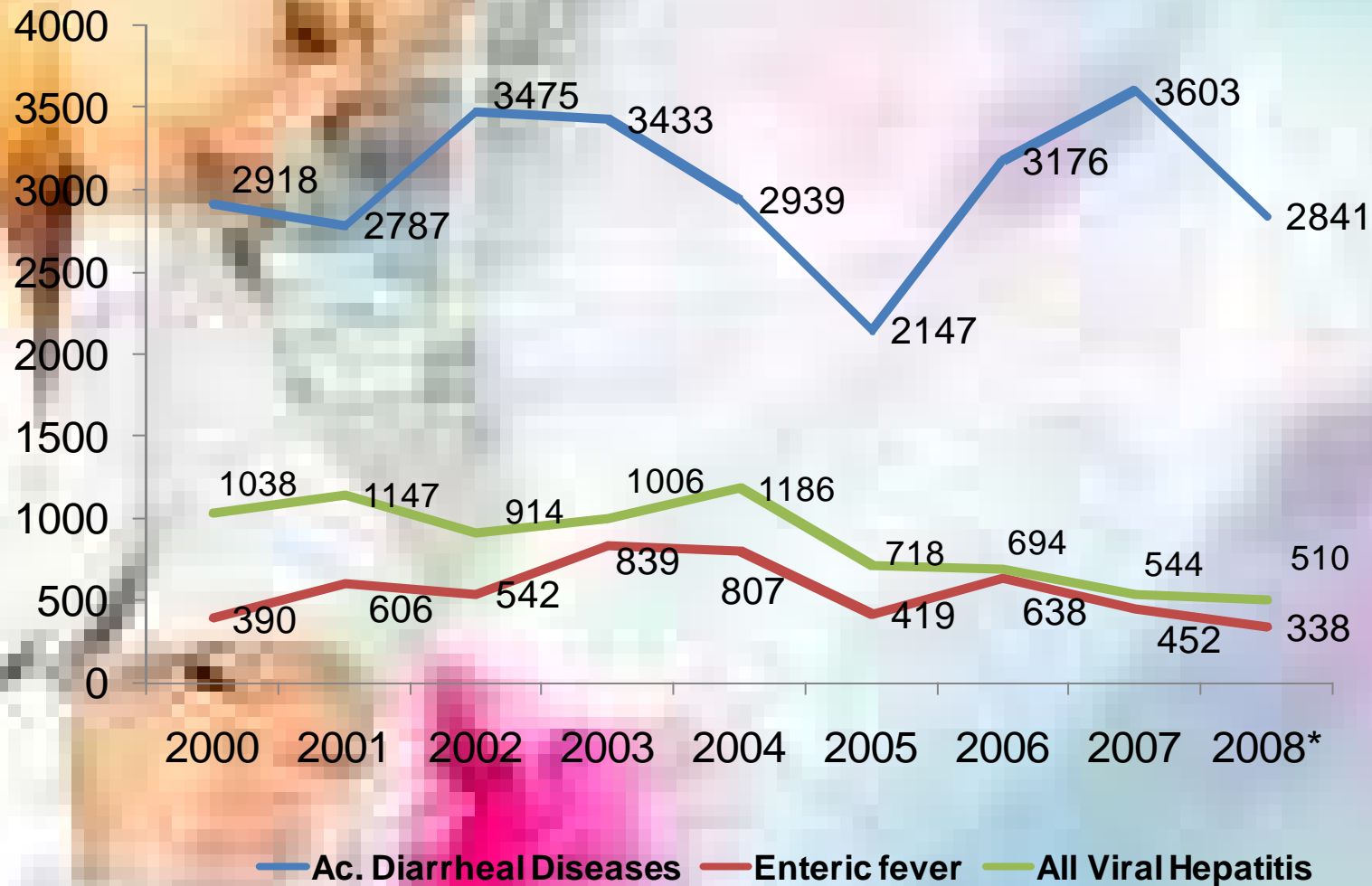

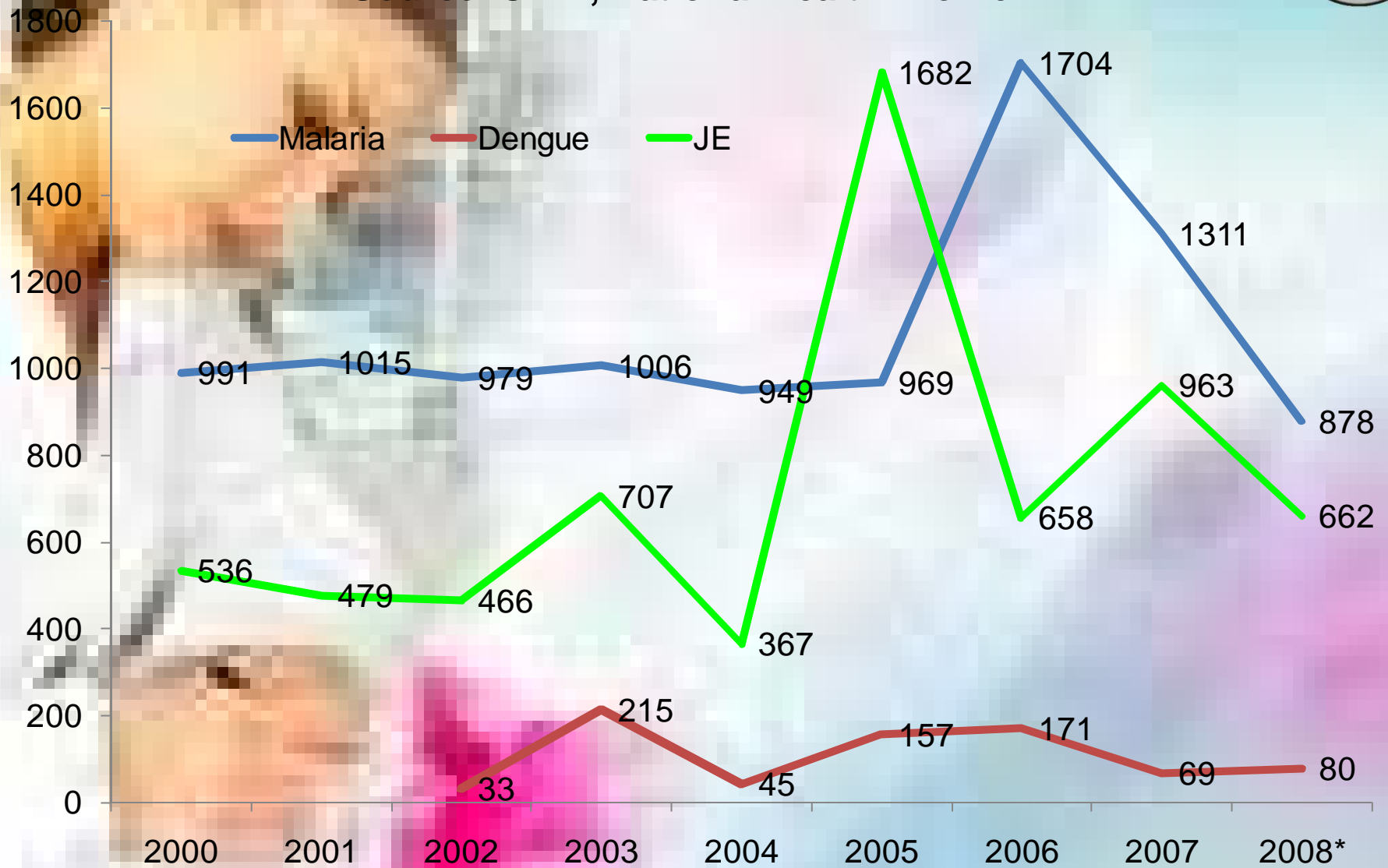

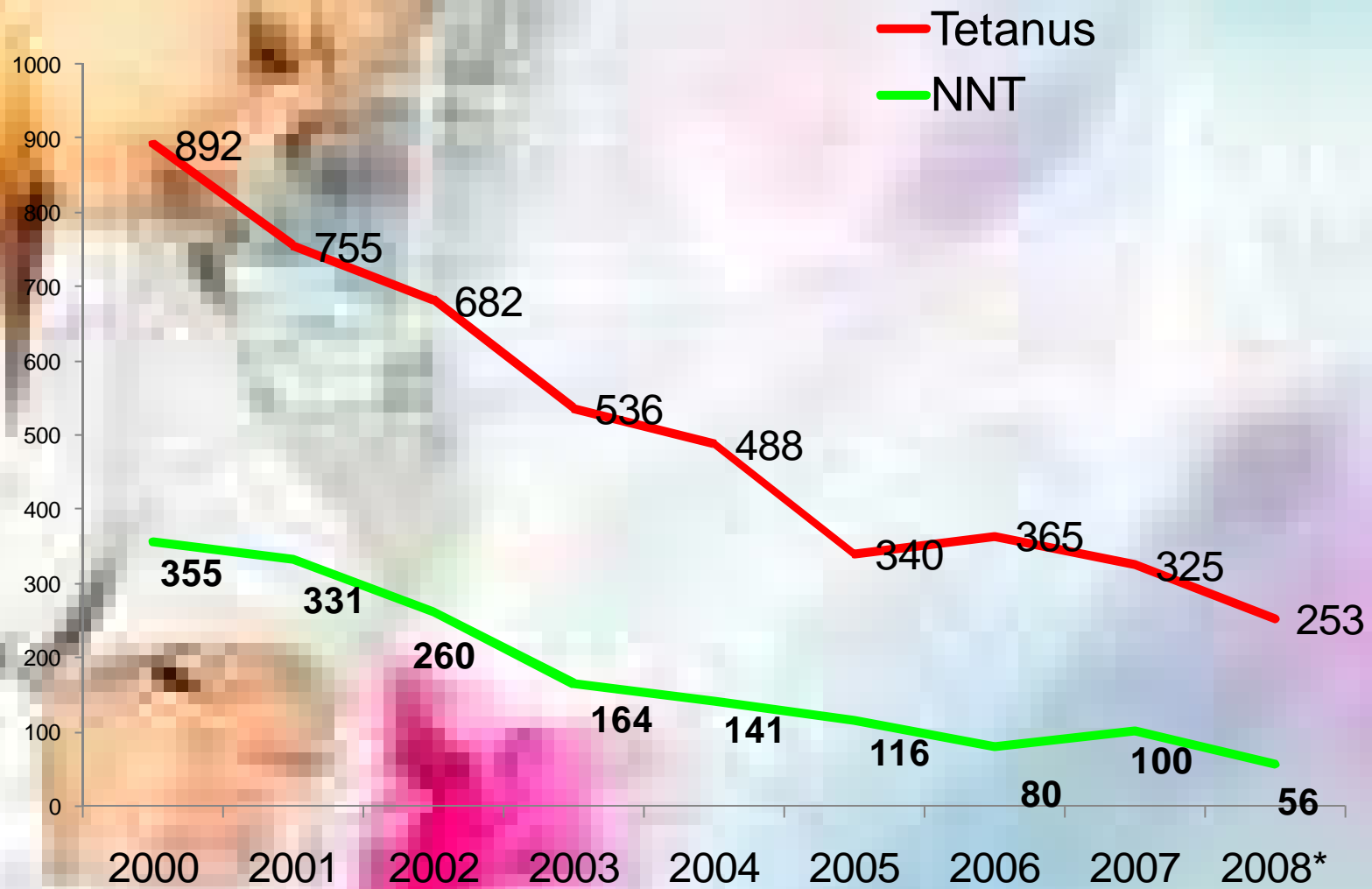

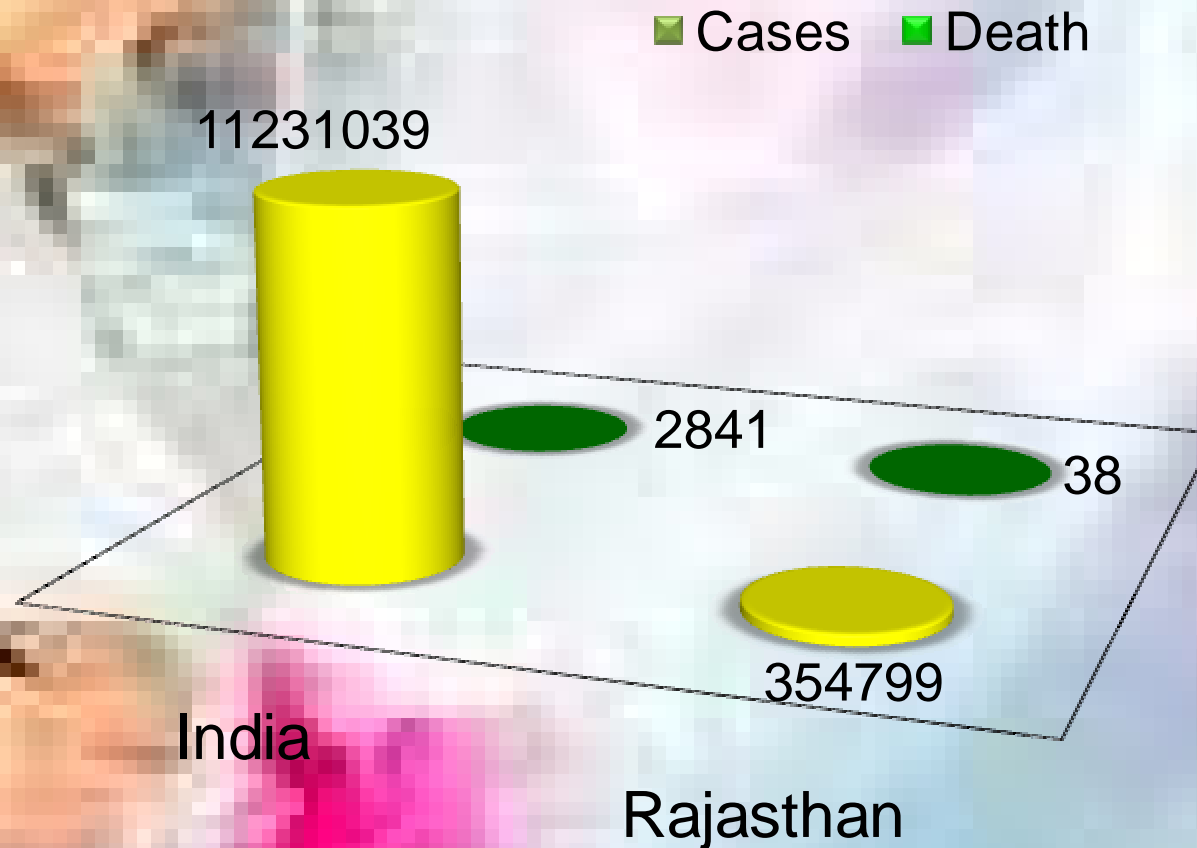

Cases and Deaths Due to Acute Diarrhoeal Disease, Dec. 2008

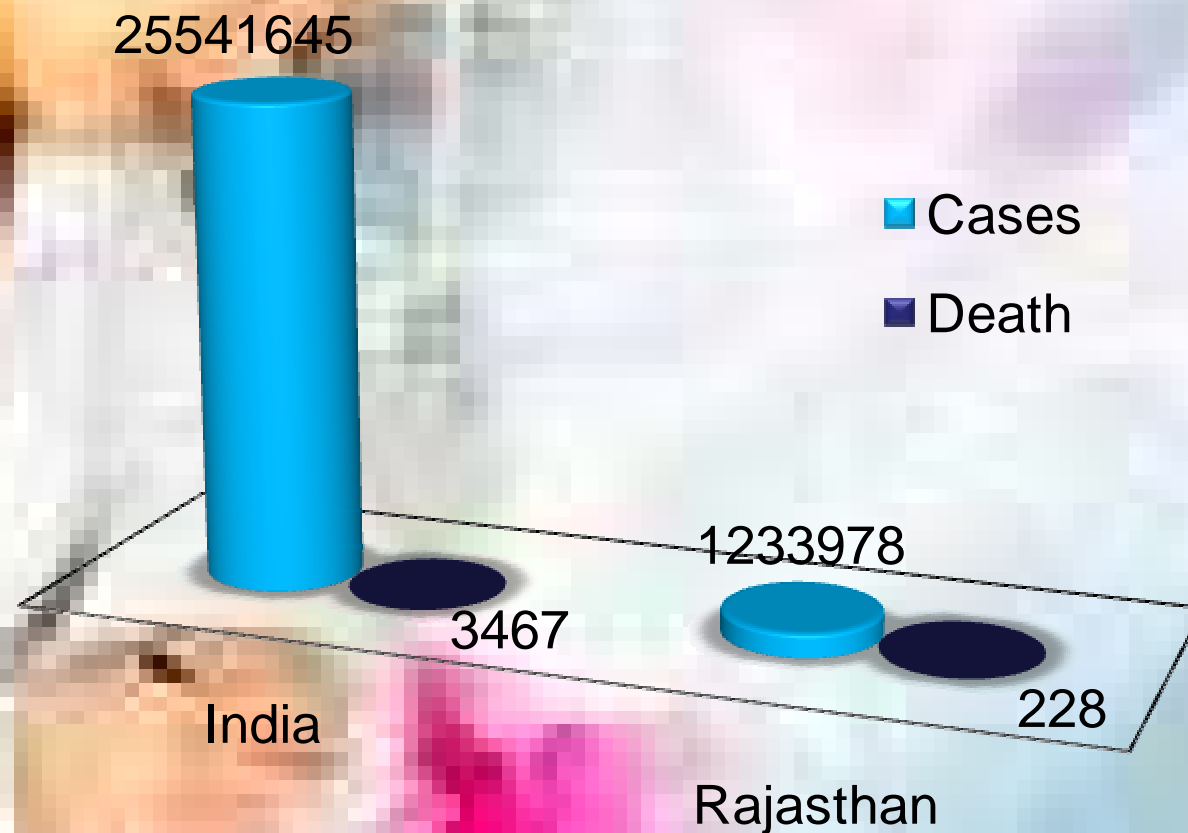

Cases and Deaths: Acute Respiratory Infection , Dec. 2008

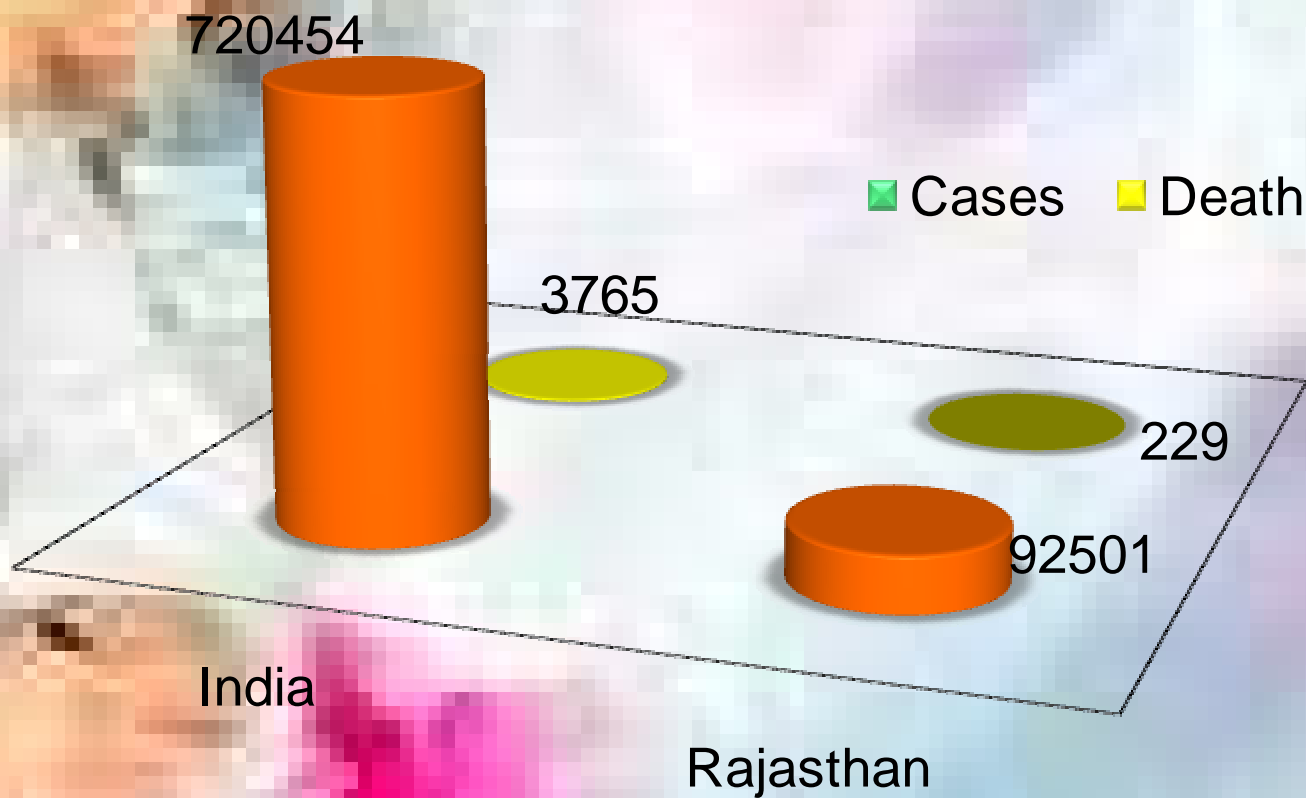

Cases and Deaths: Pneumonia, Dec. 2008



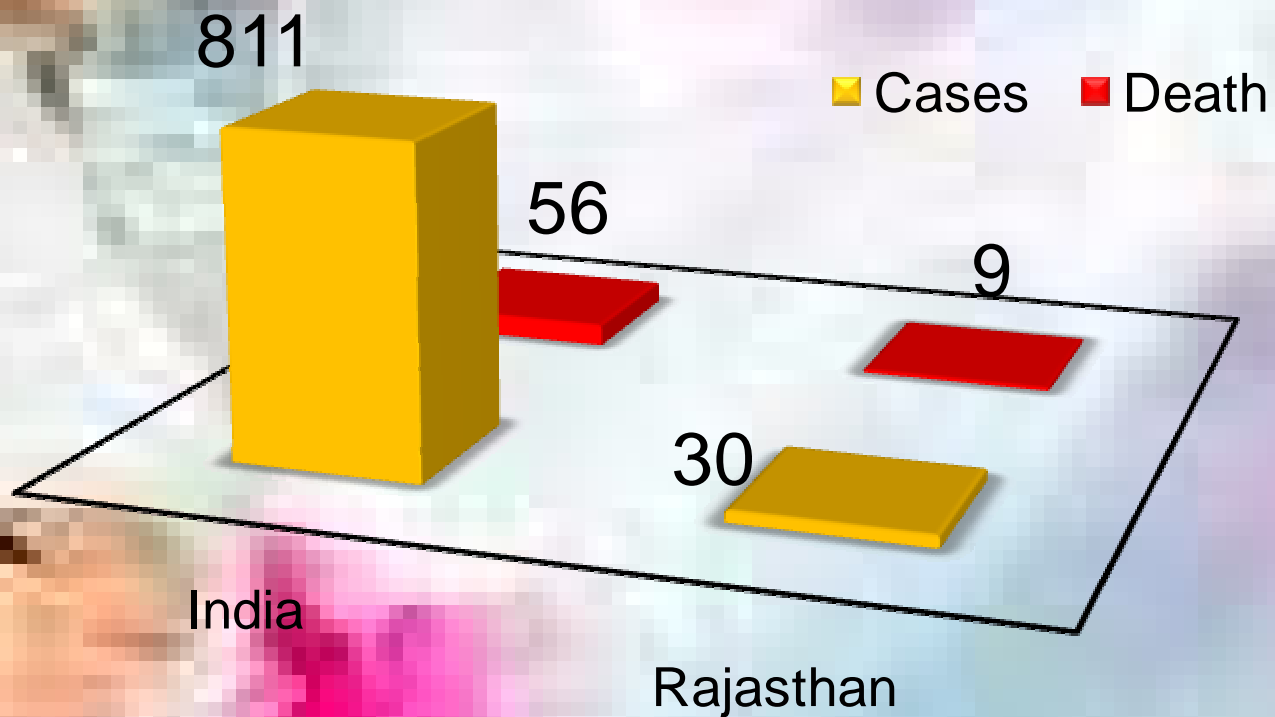

Cases and Deaths: Neonatal Tetanus, Dec. 2008

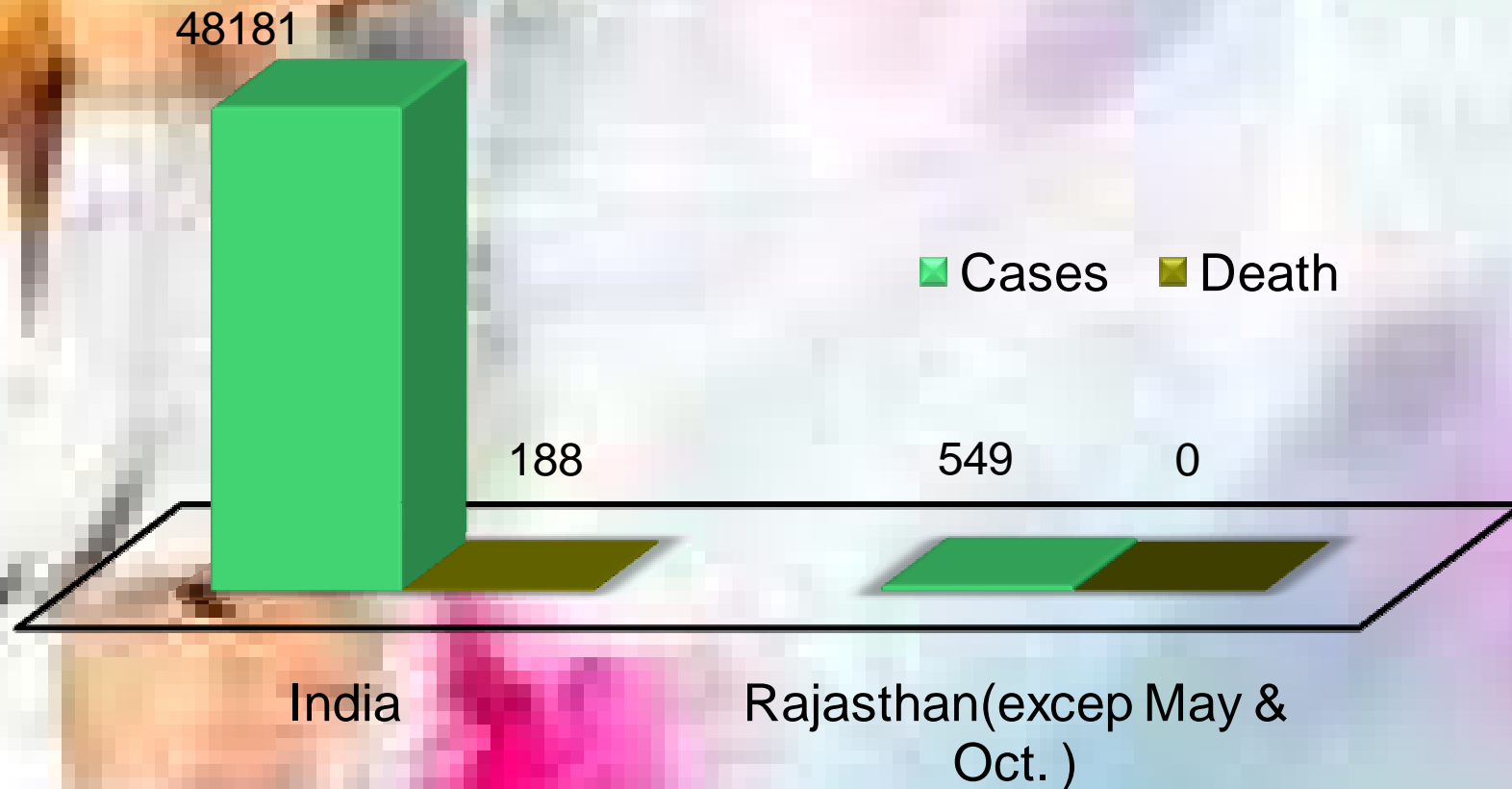

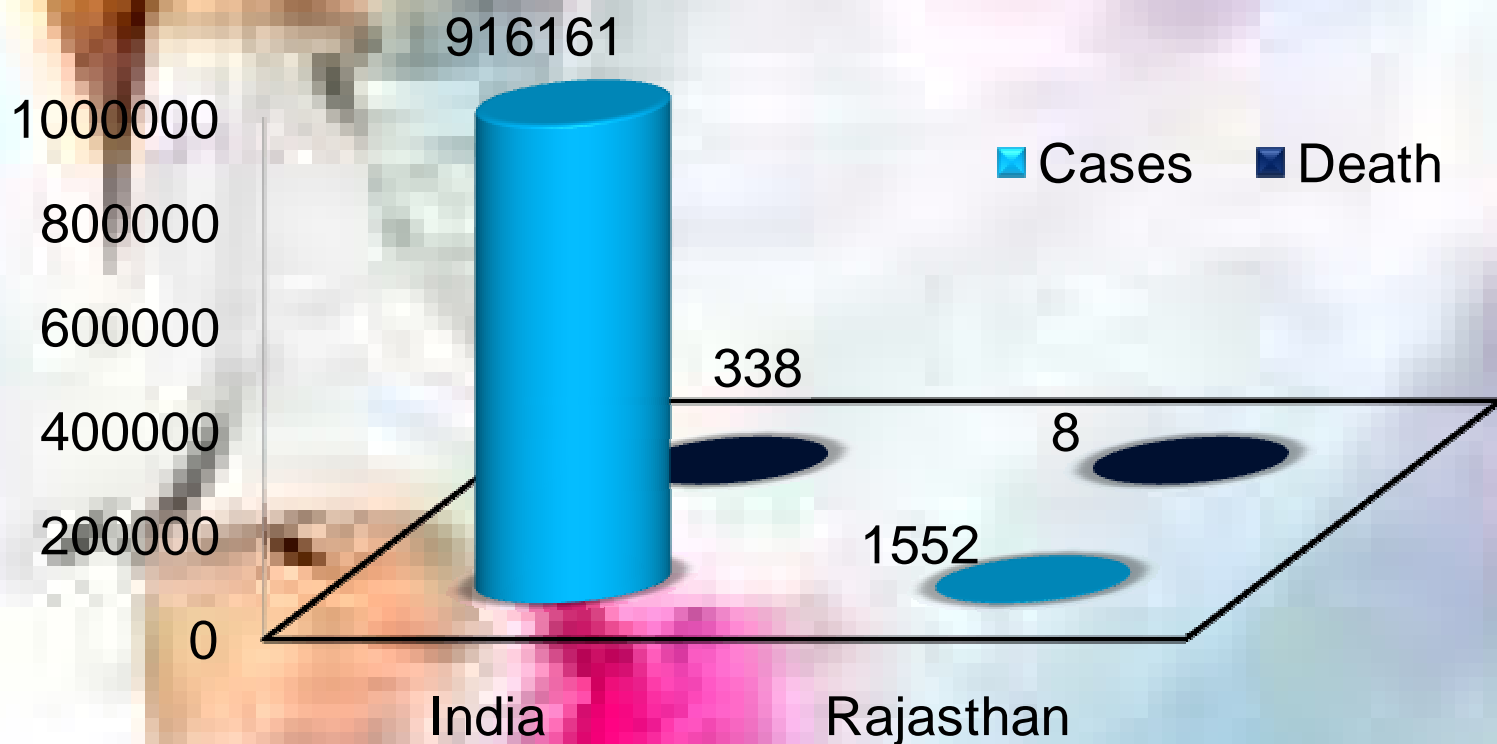

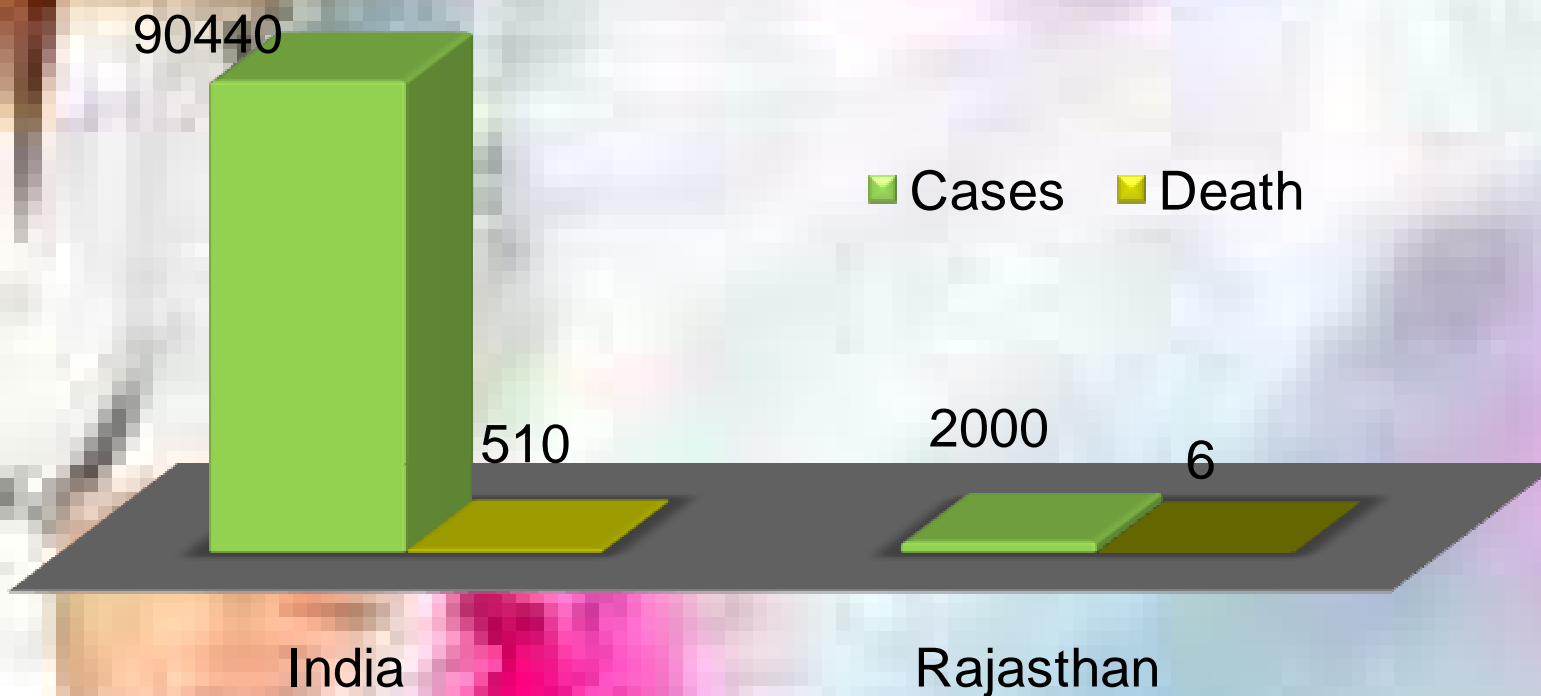

Cases and Deaths: Viral Hepatitis (All Causes), Dec.2008

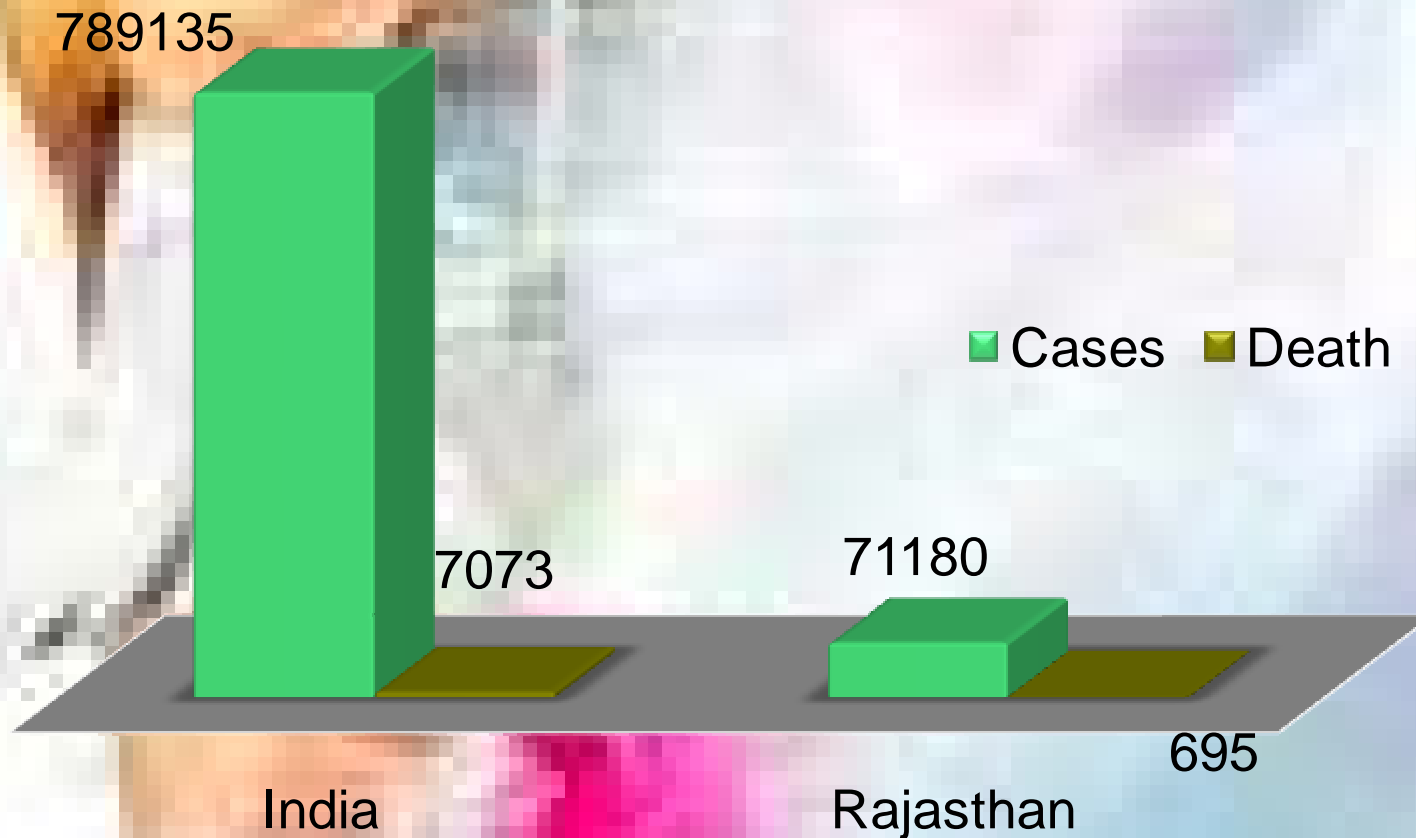

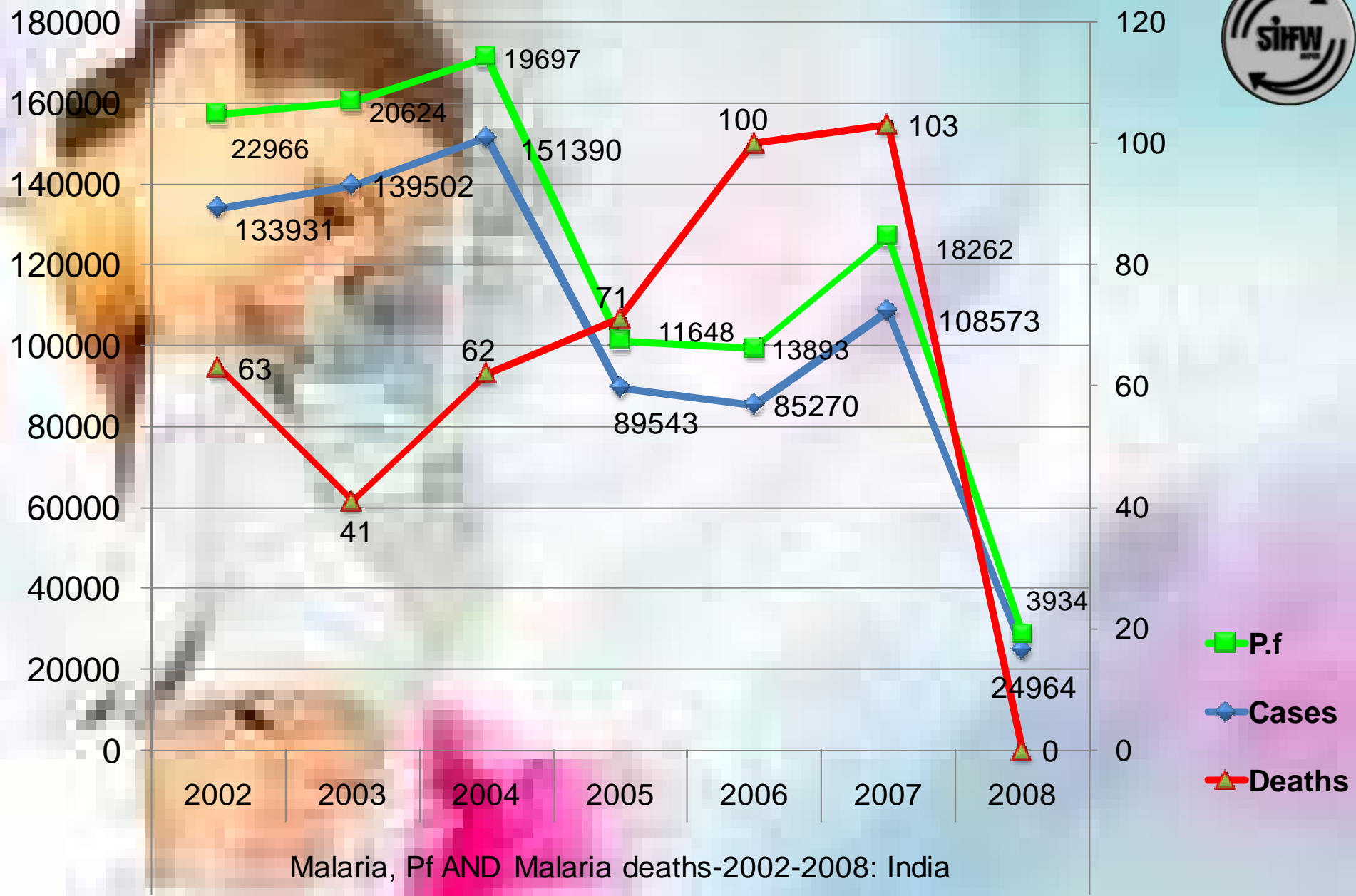




Cases and Deaths: Pulmonary Tuberculosis, 2006

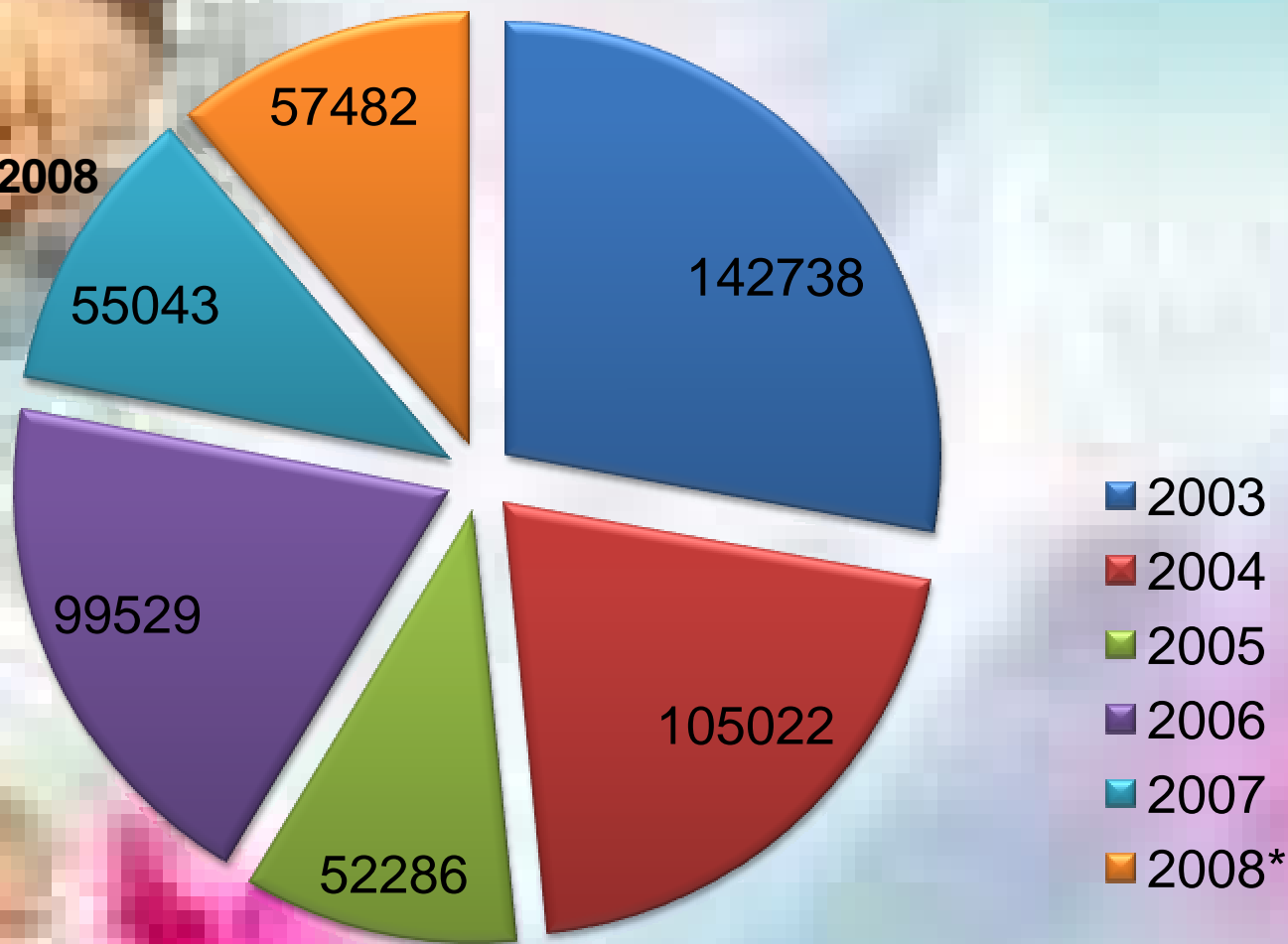


Malaria, Pf AND Malaria deaths-2002-2008: India

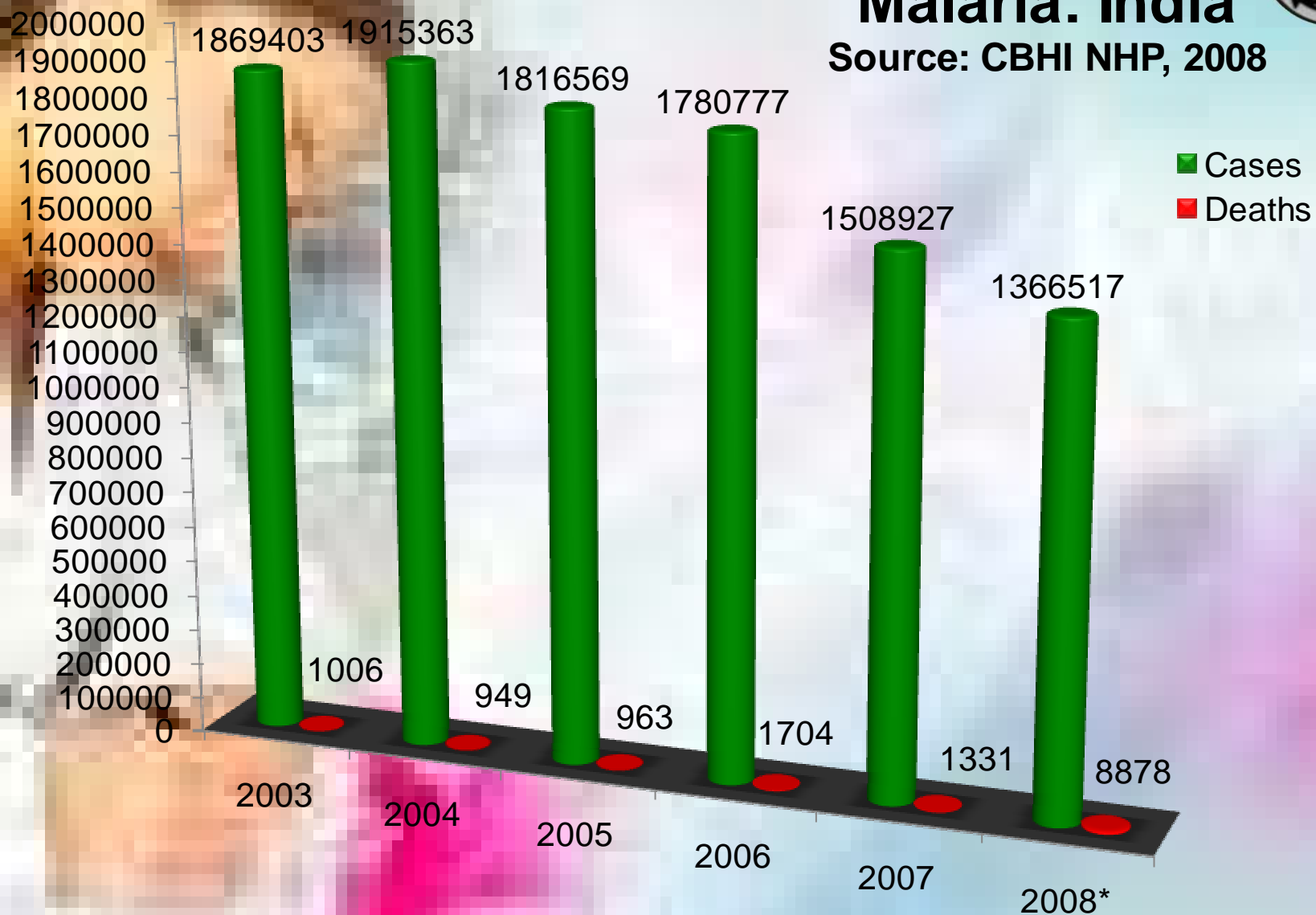

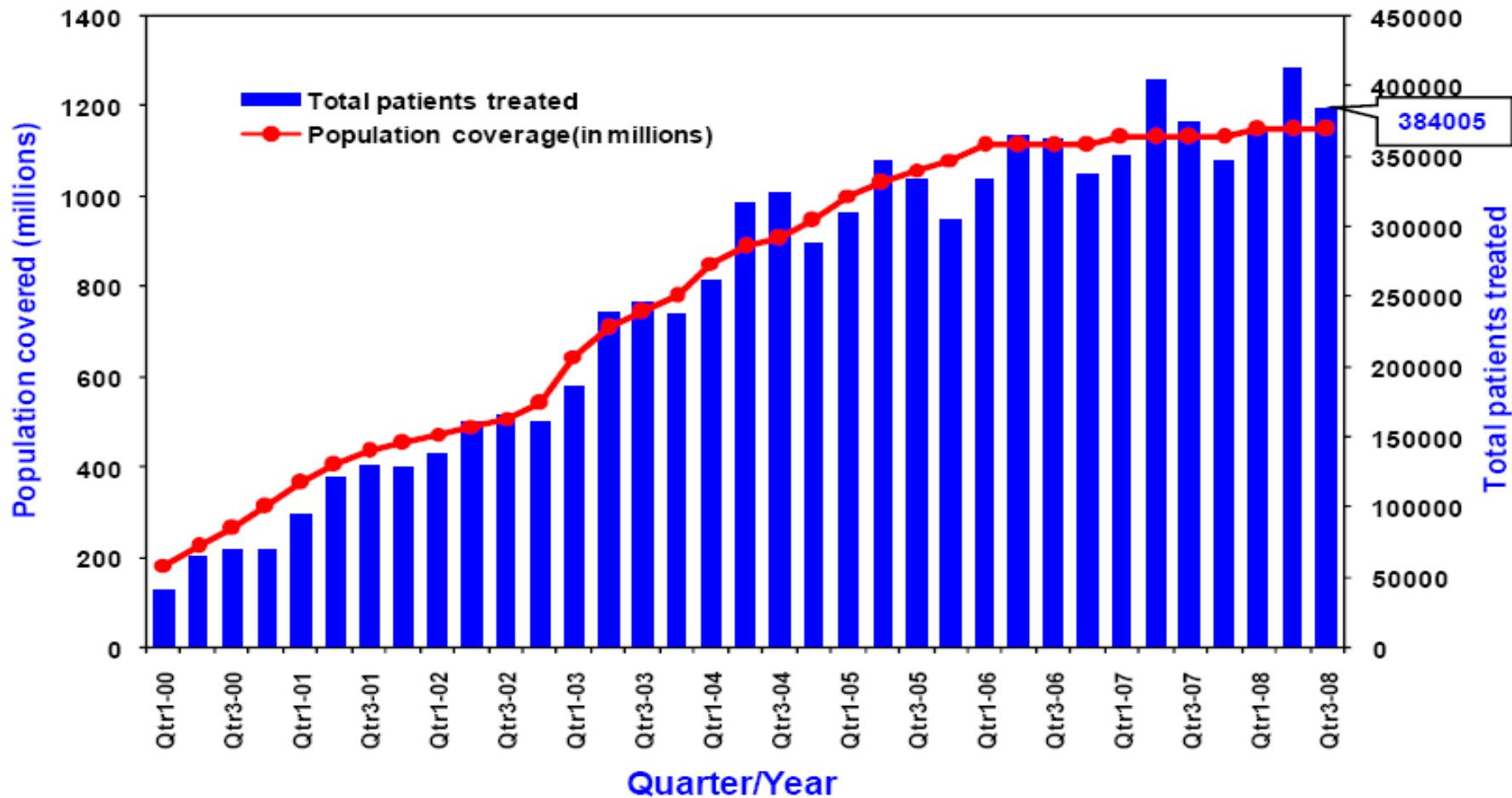

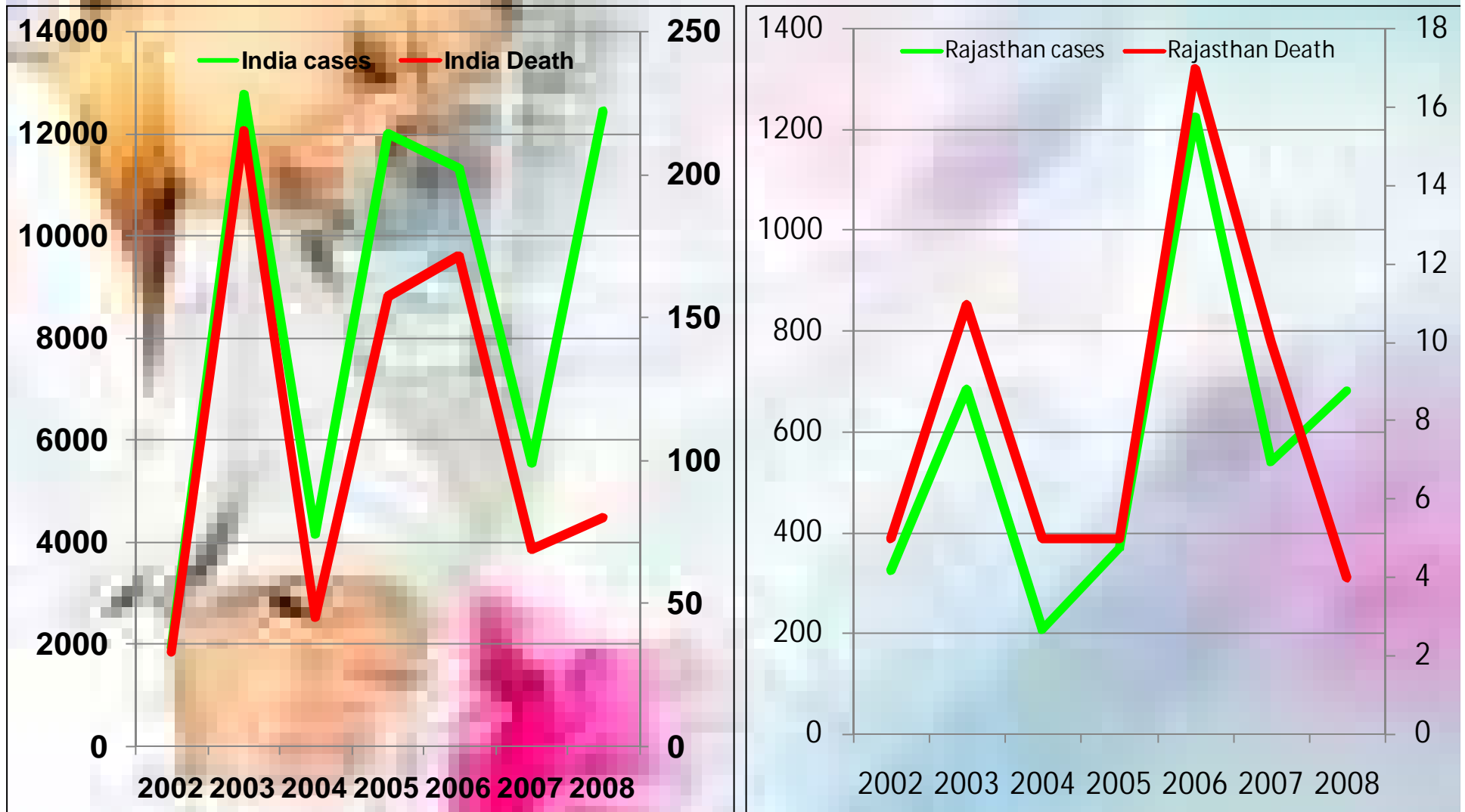


Population in India covered under DOTS and total tuberculosis patients put on treatment each quarter



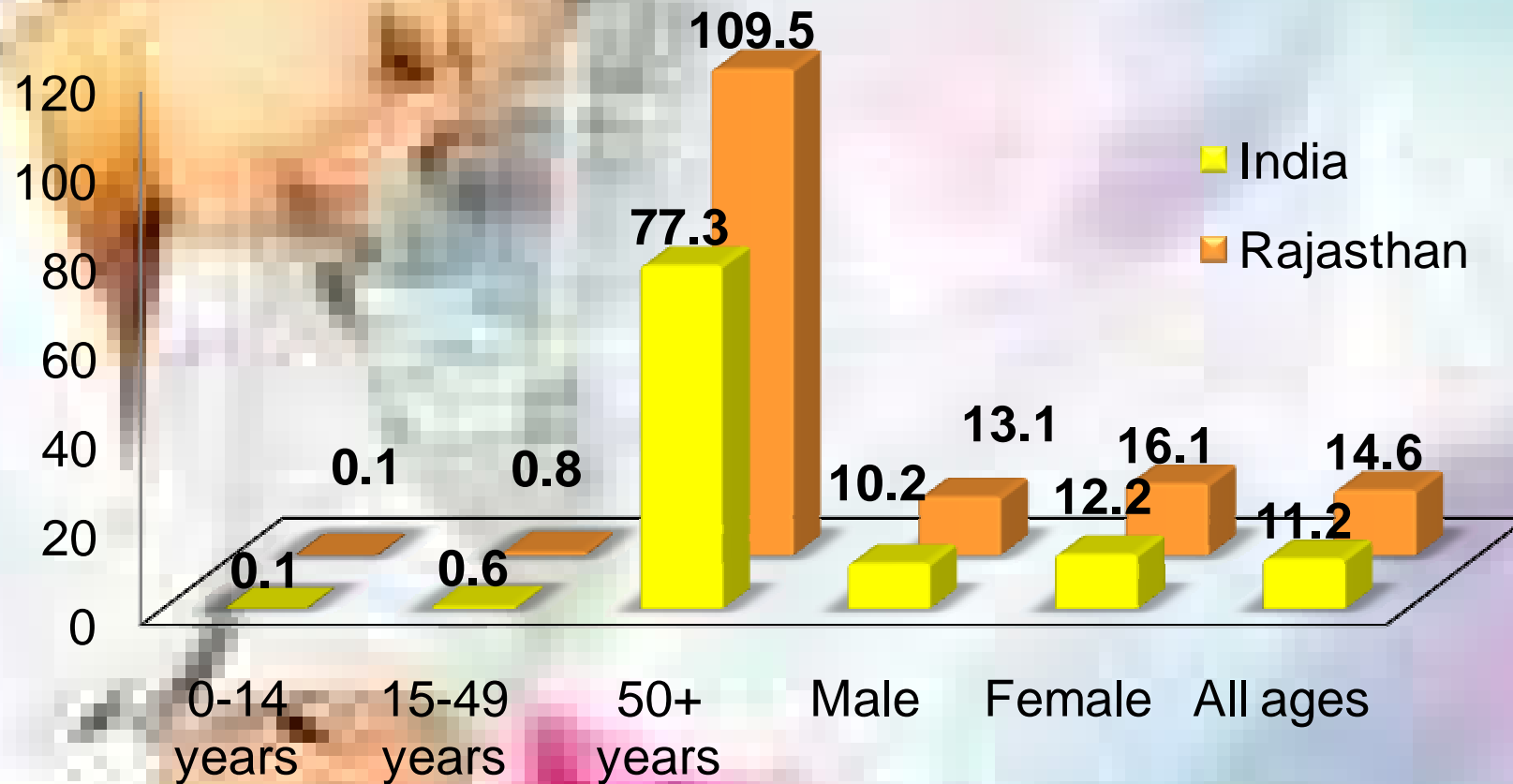
Dengue: Cases & Deaths (2002-2008)

Prevalence of Blindness in India 2004, Per 1000 population

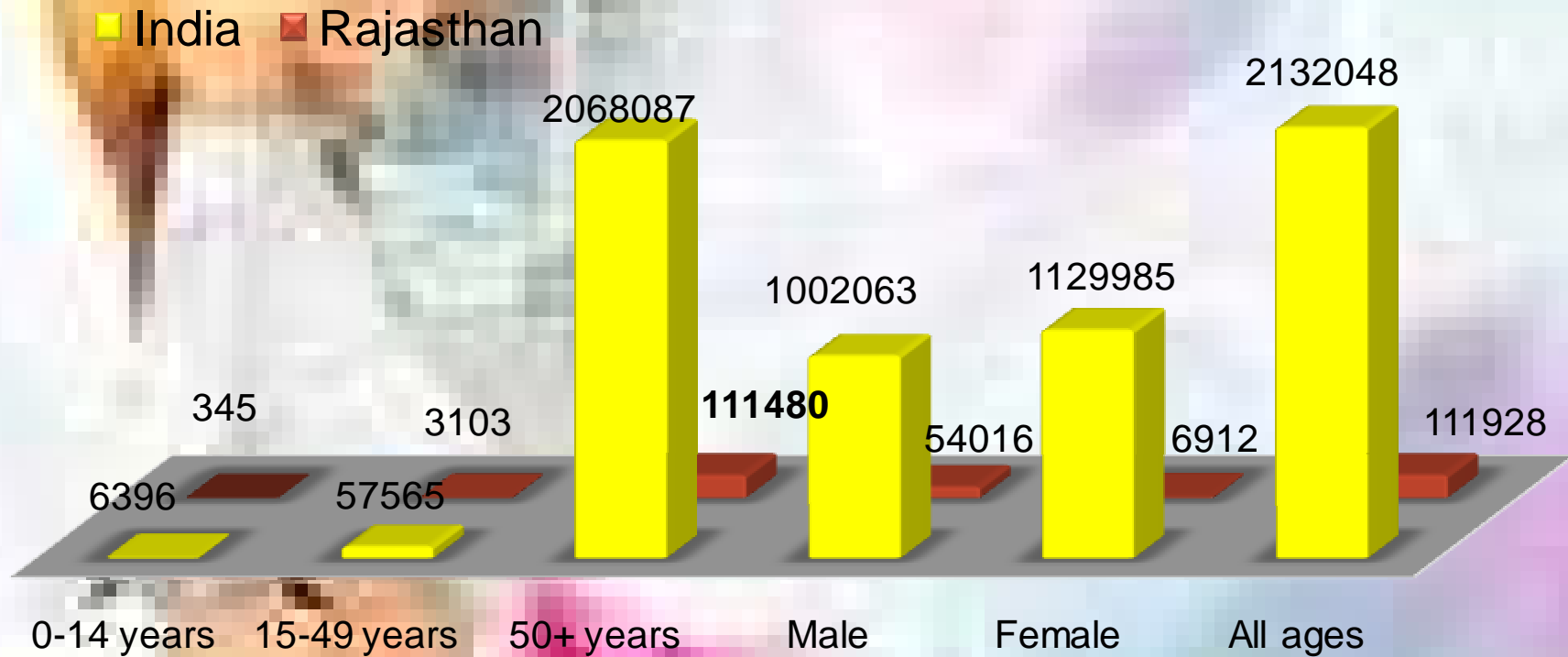

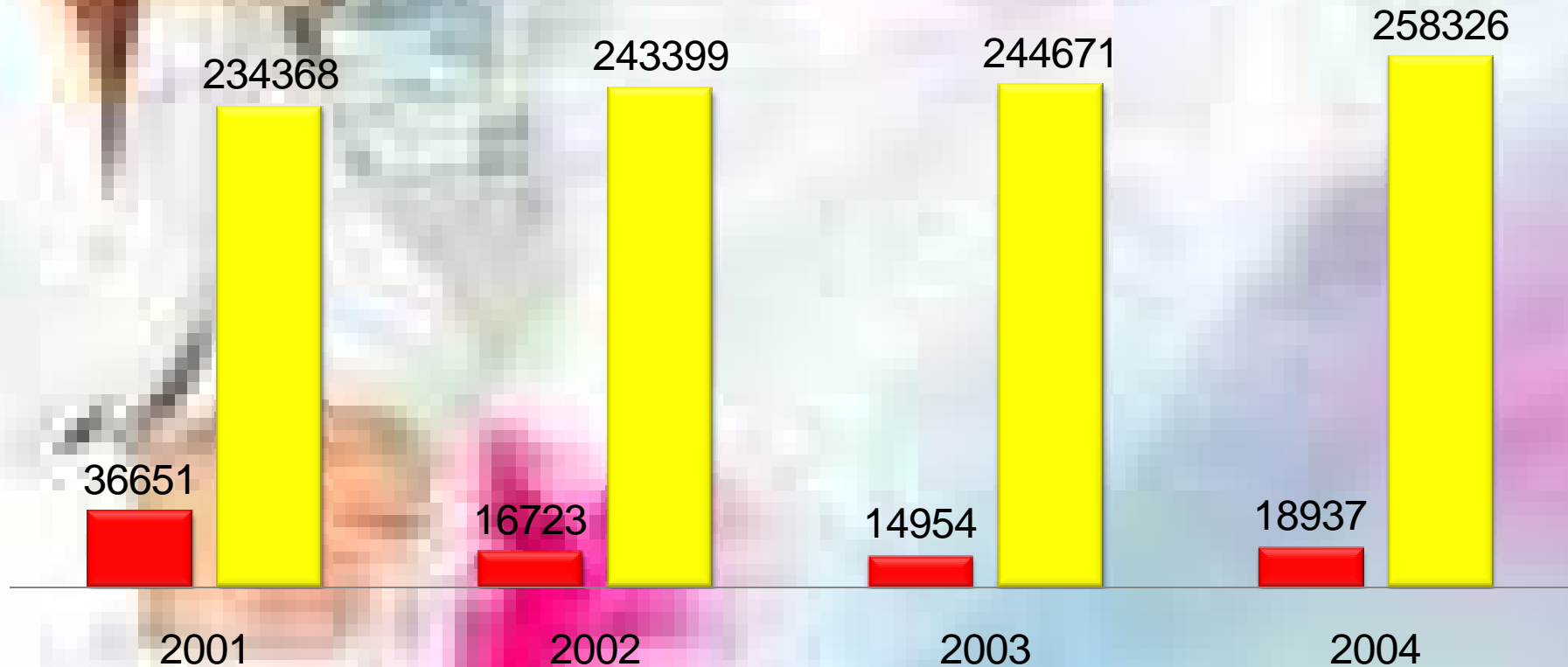




Incidence of Deaths due to Accidents in India 2001-2004

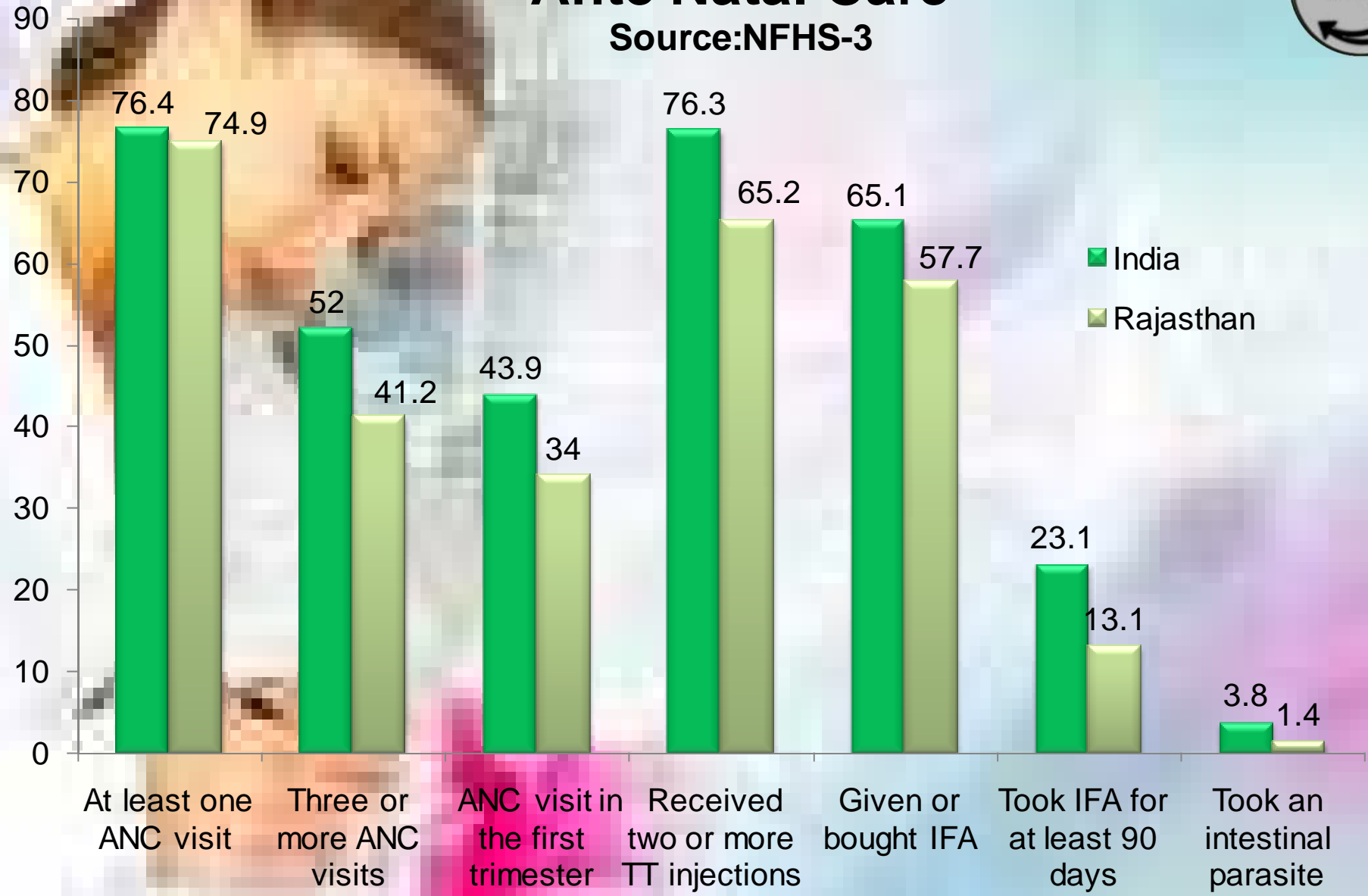

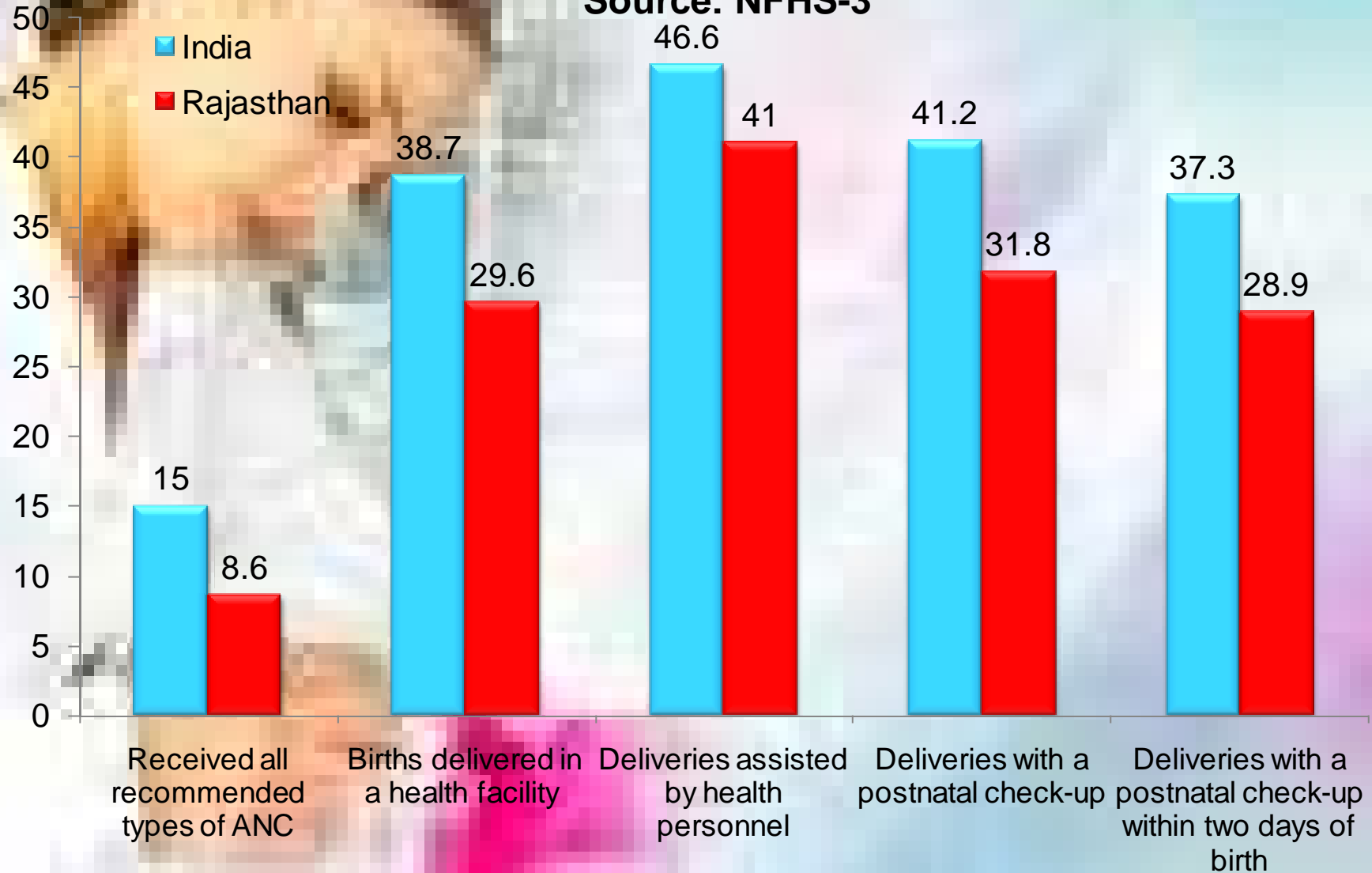

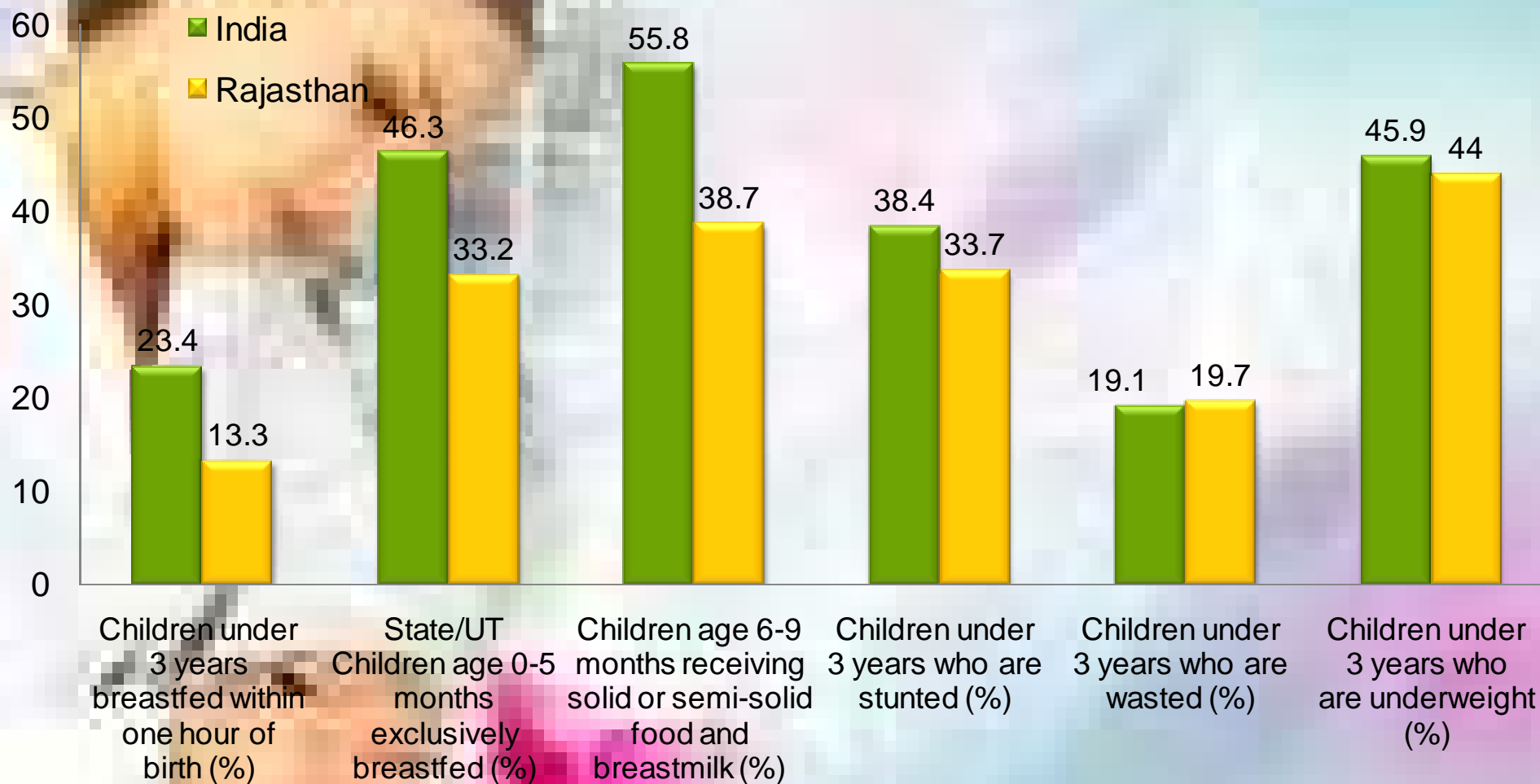

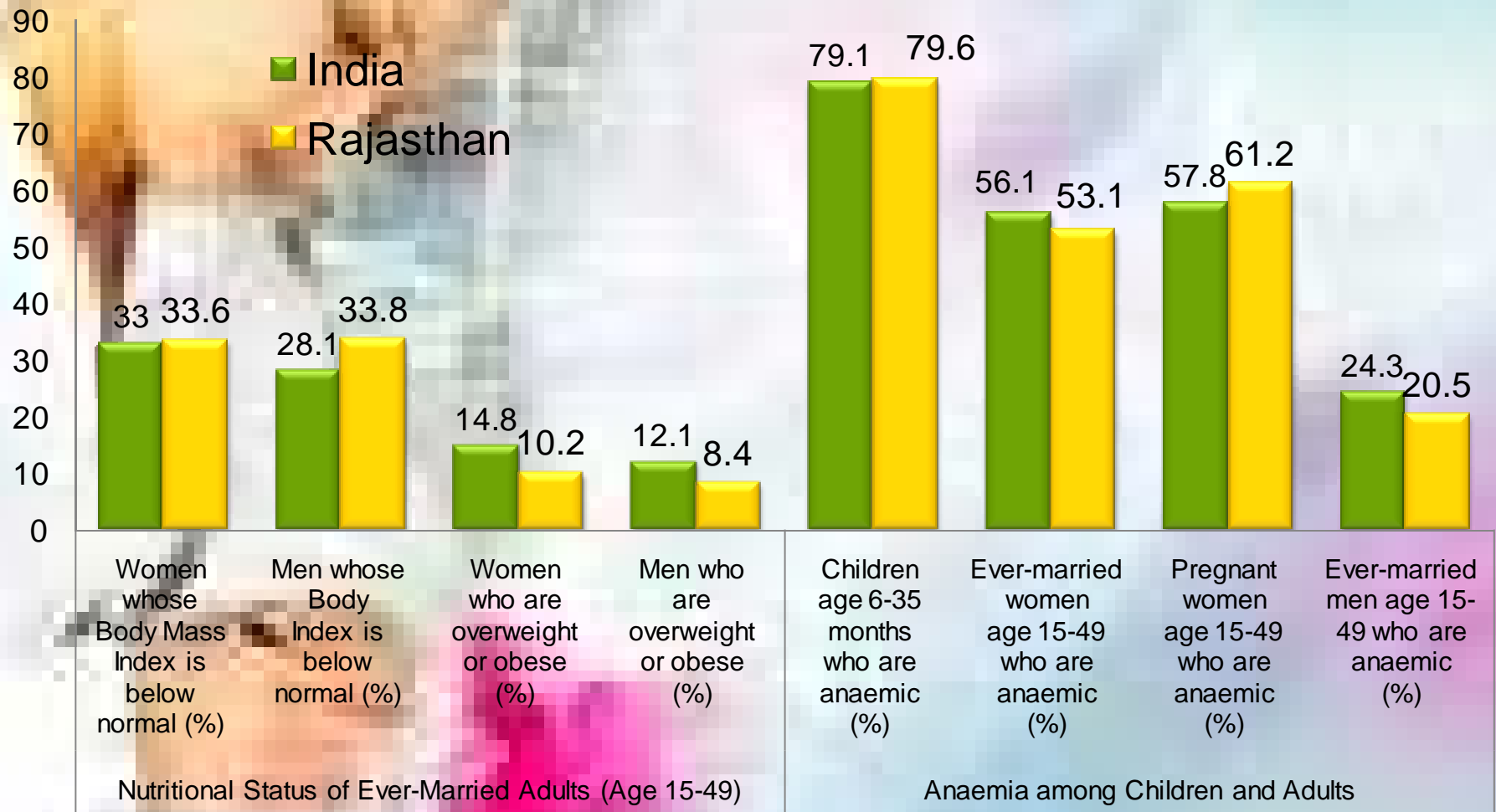

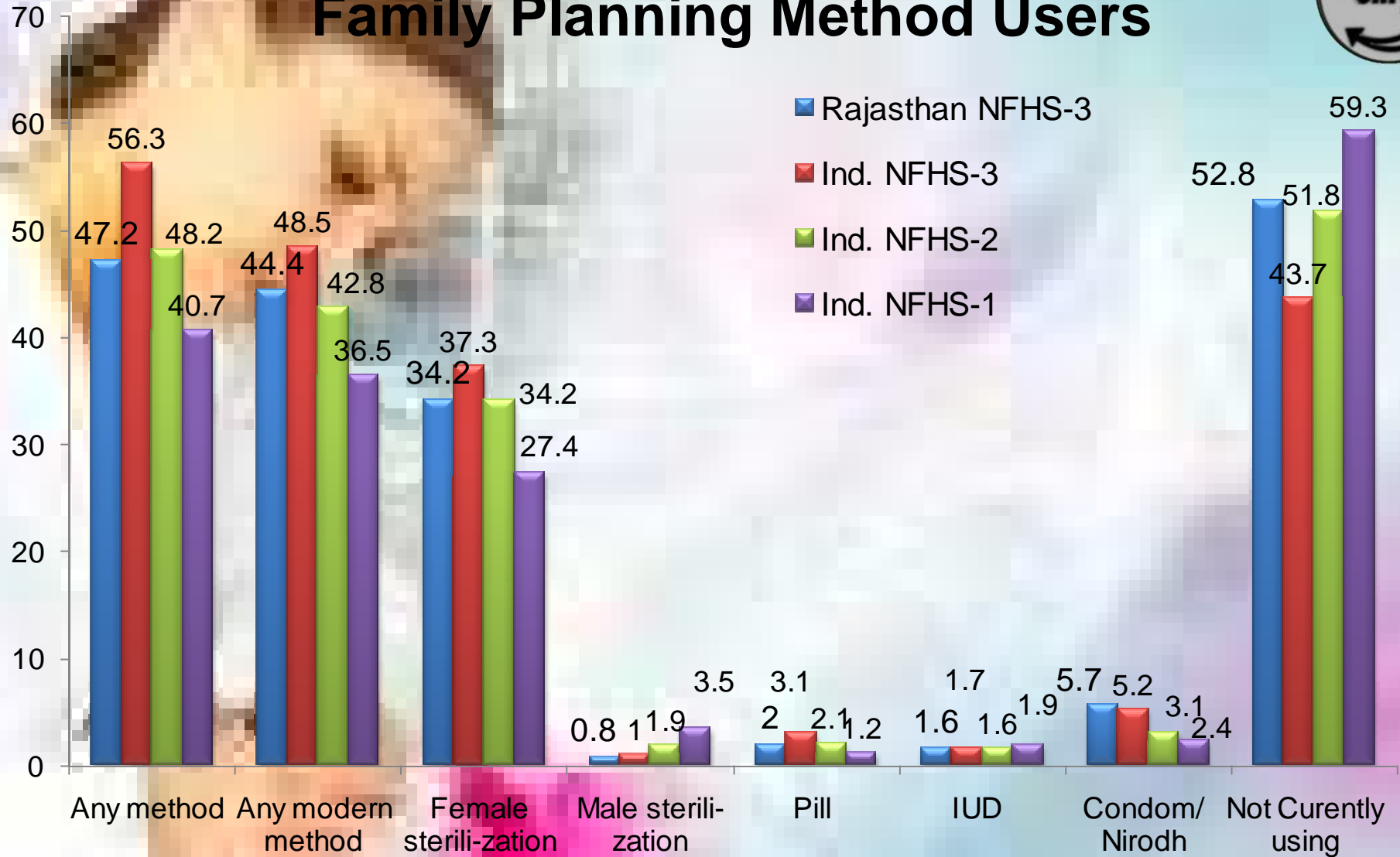
Anemia among Children and Adults, 2005-2006

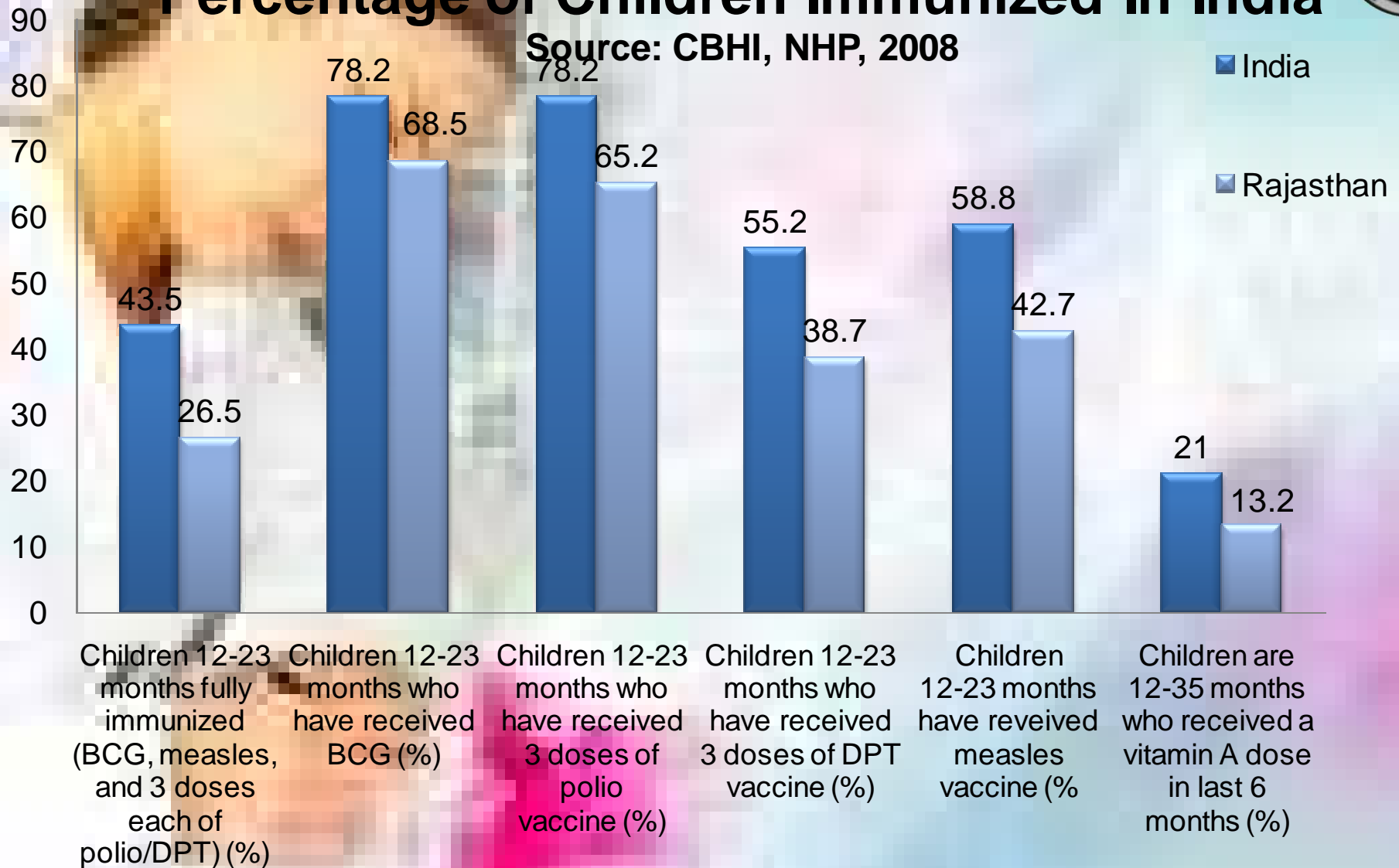
Family Planning Method Users





Percentage of Children Immunized In India

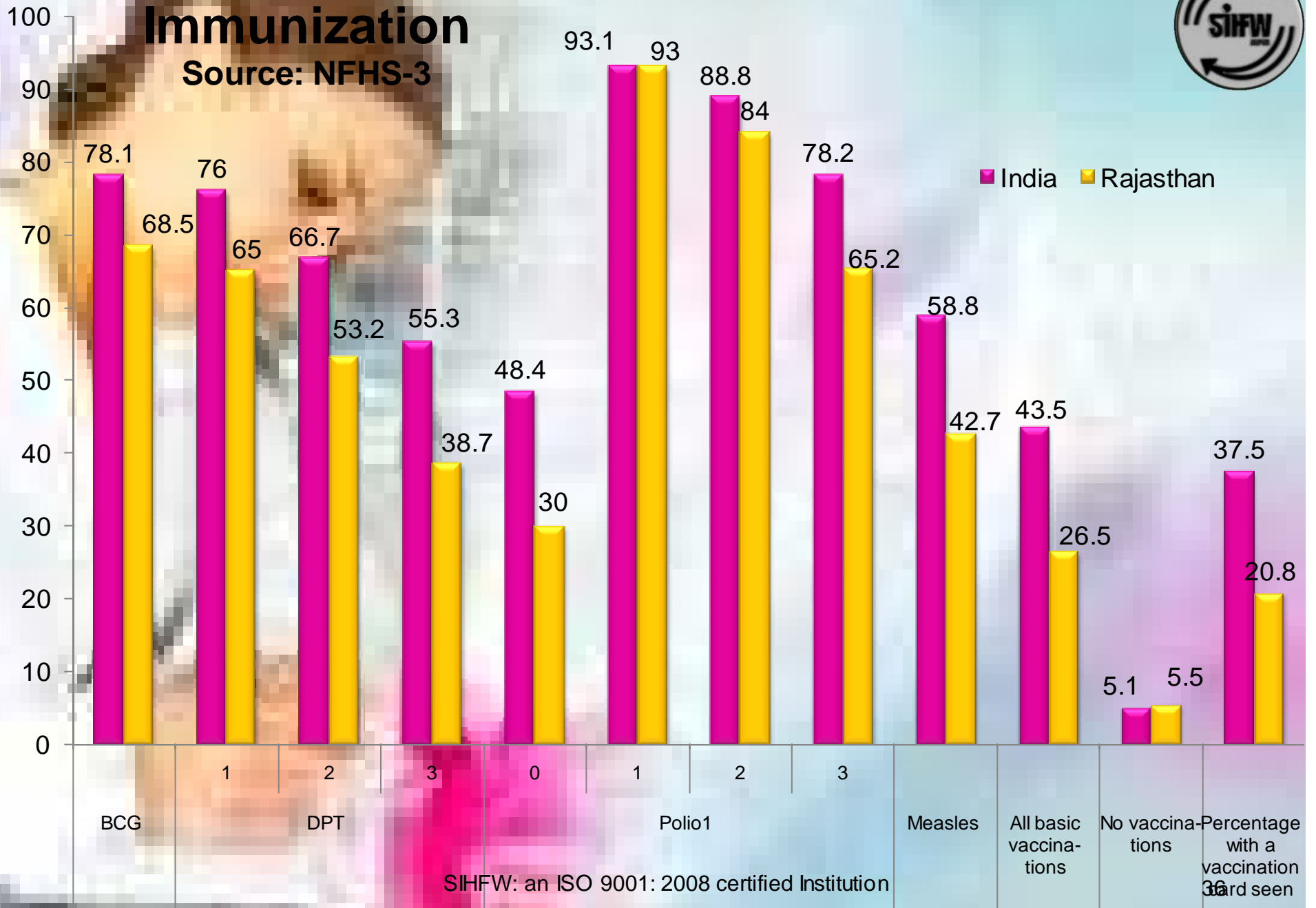
